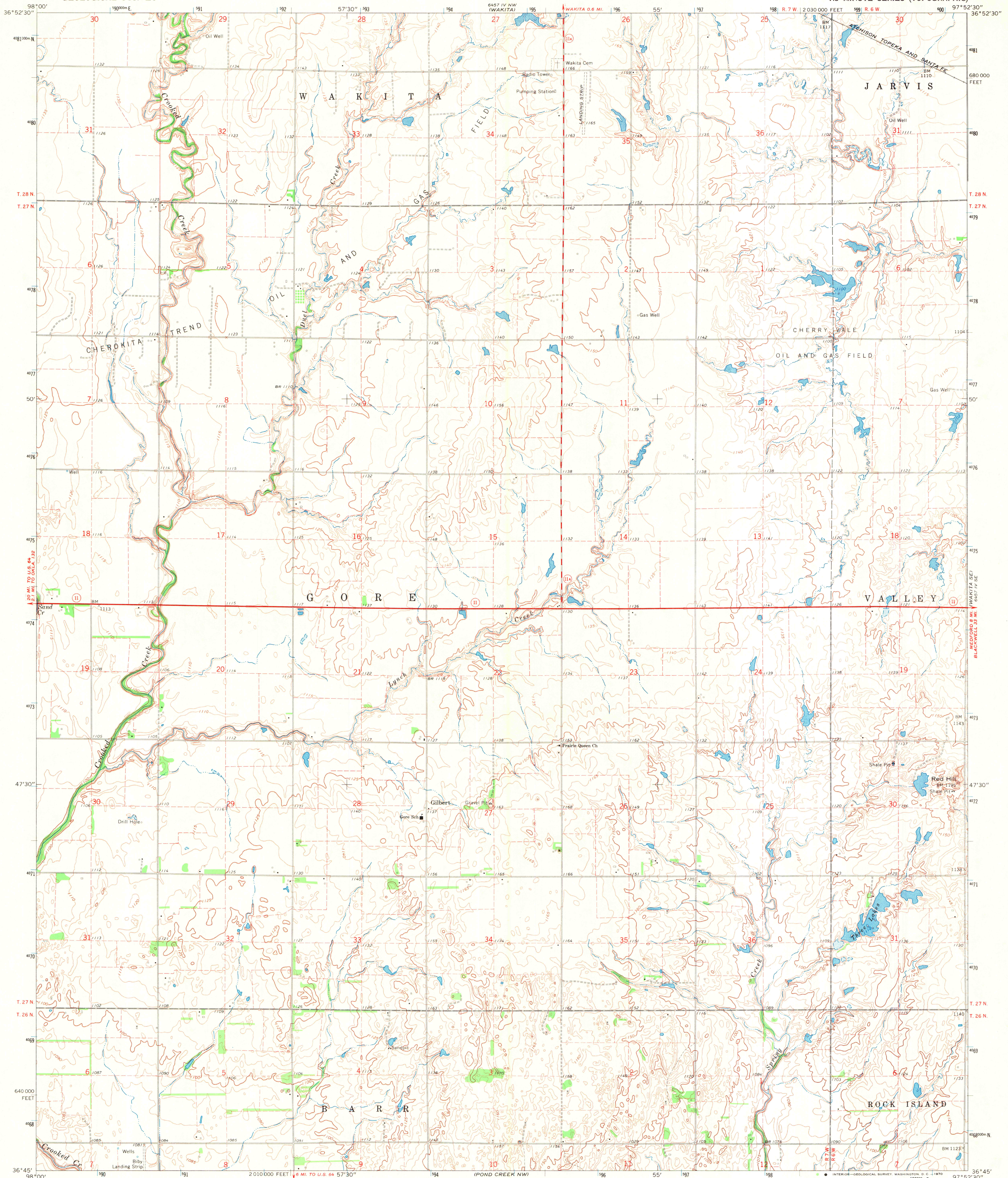

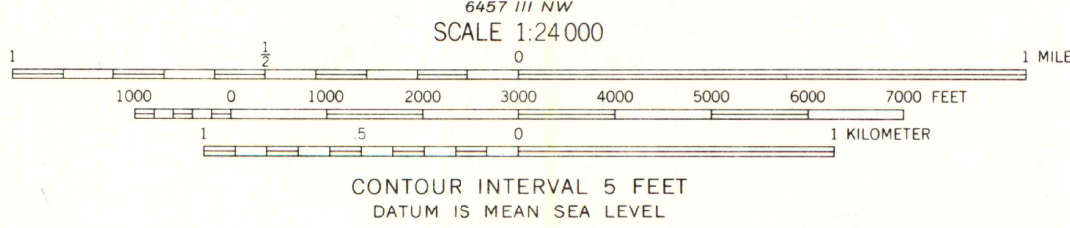
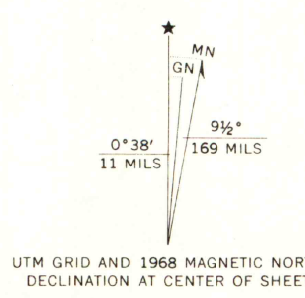
10,000-foot grid based on Oklahoma coordinate system, north zone

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,

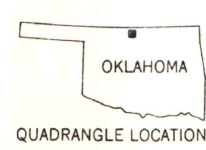
