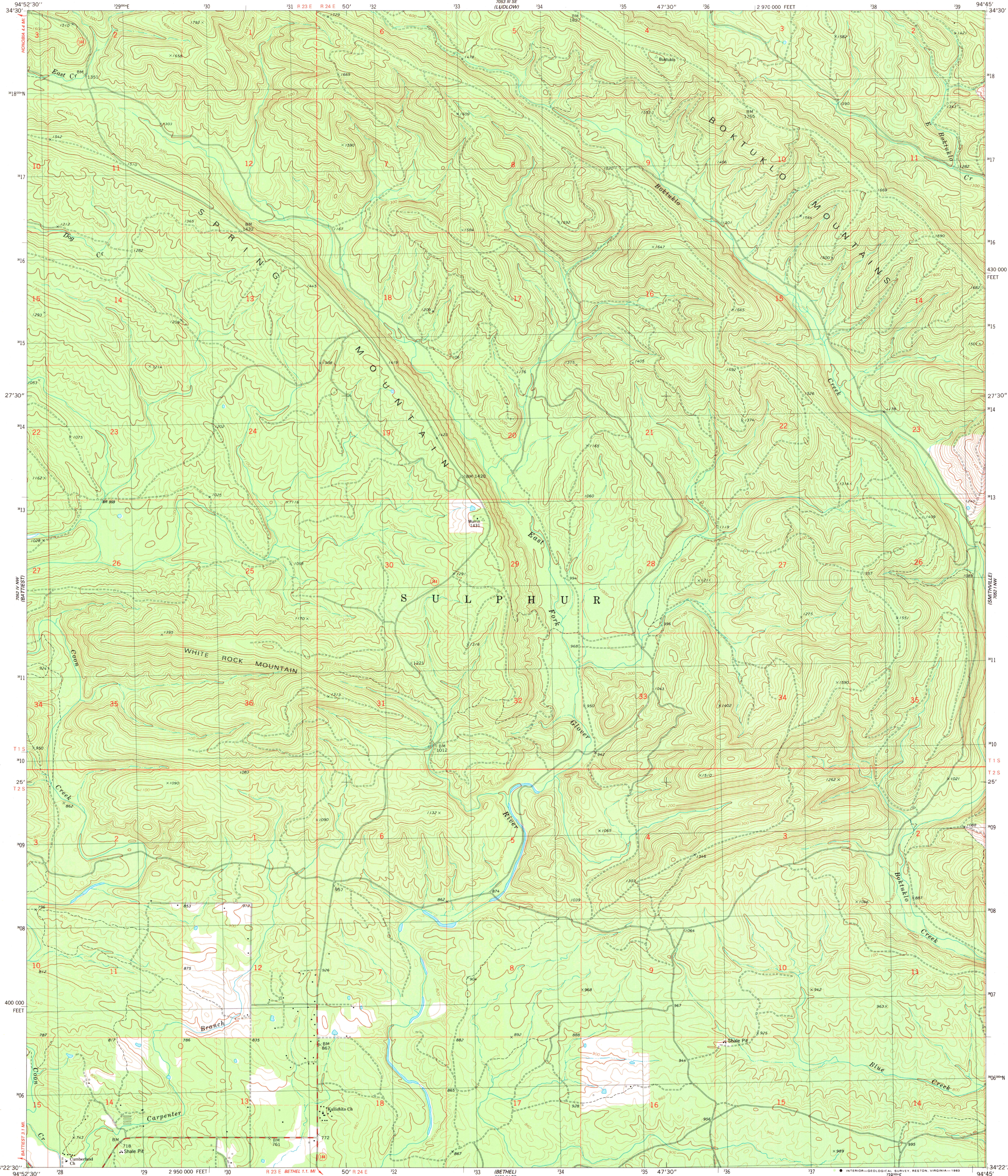

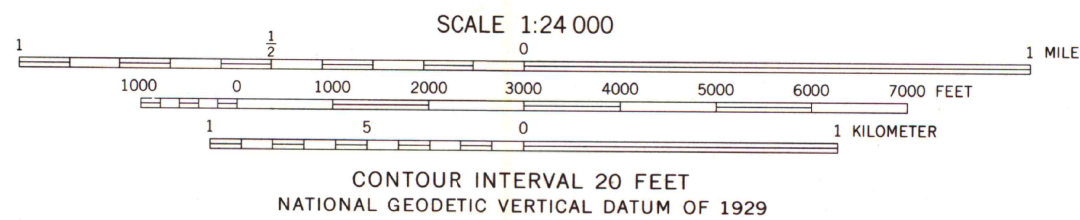
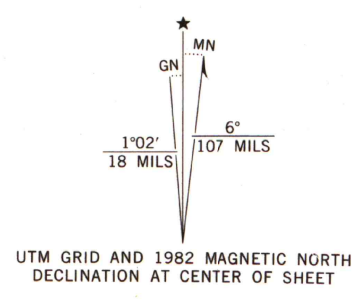
Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: Oklahoma coordinate system, south zone (Lambert conformal conic)

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid, zone 15

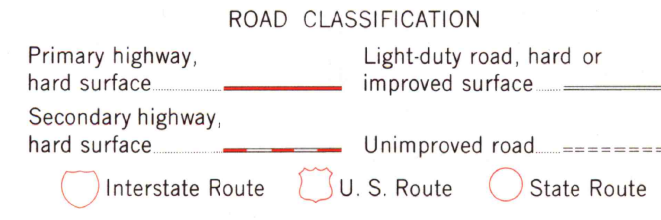
1927 North American Datum
