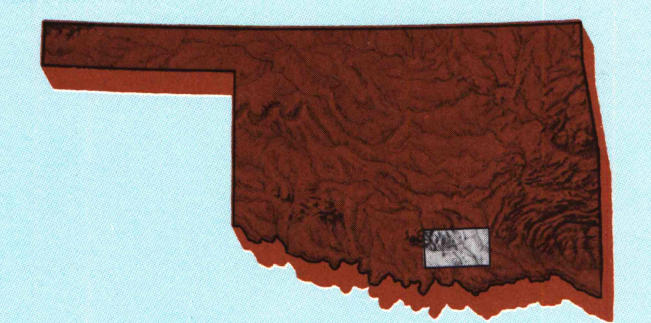


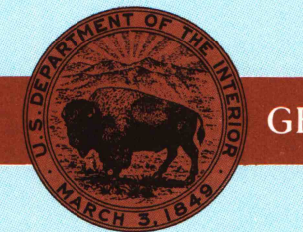
Tishomingo OKLAHOMA
