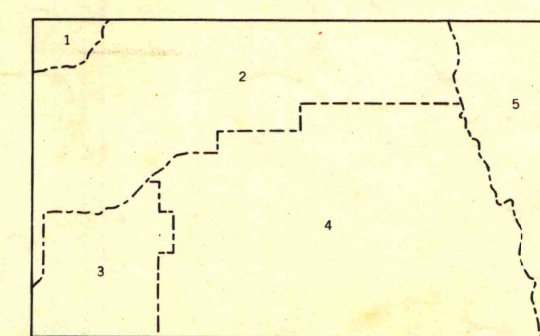

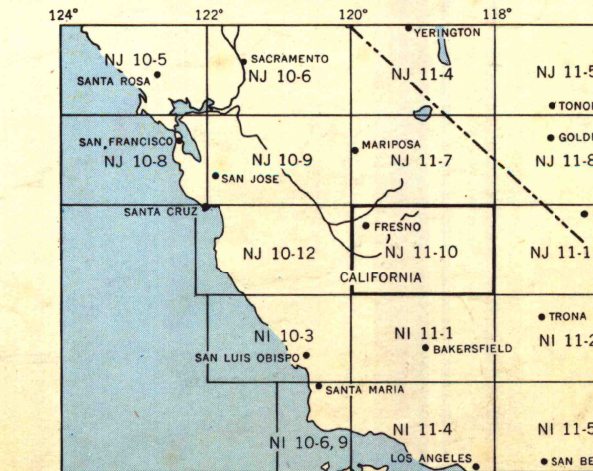

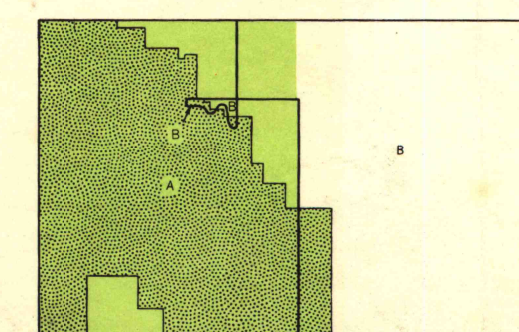

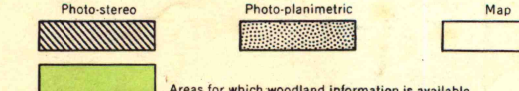
LOCATION DIAGRAM FOR NJ 11-10
