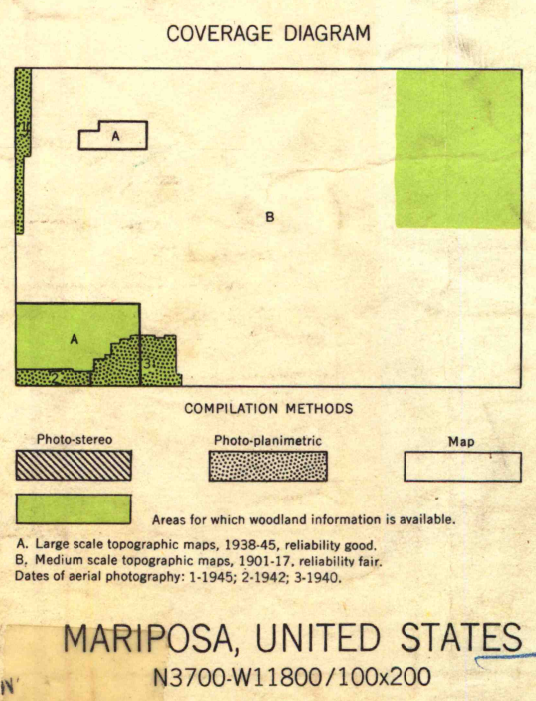
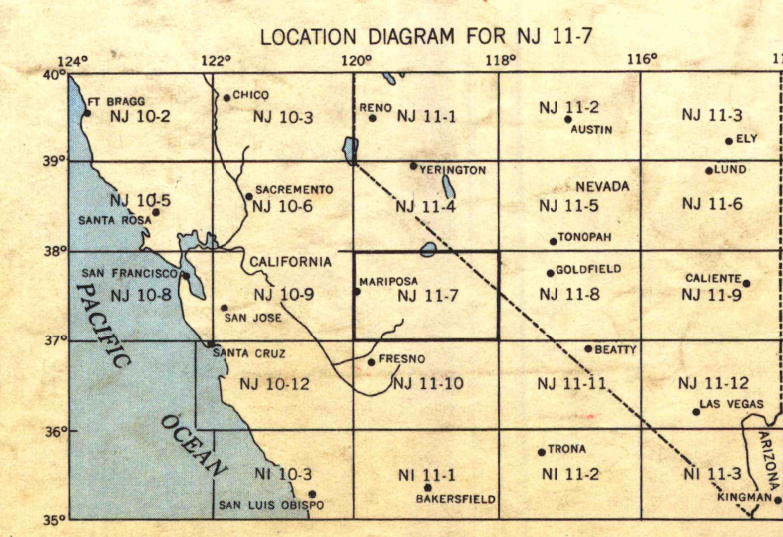


CONTOUR INTERVAL 500 FEET
