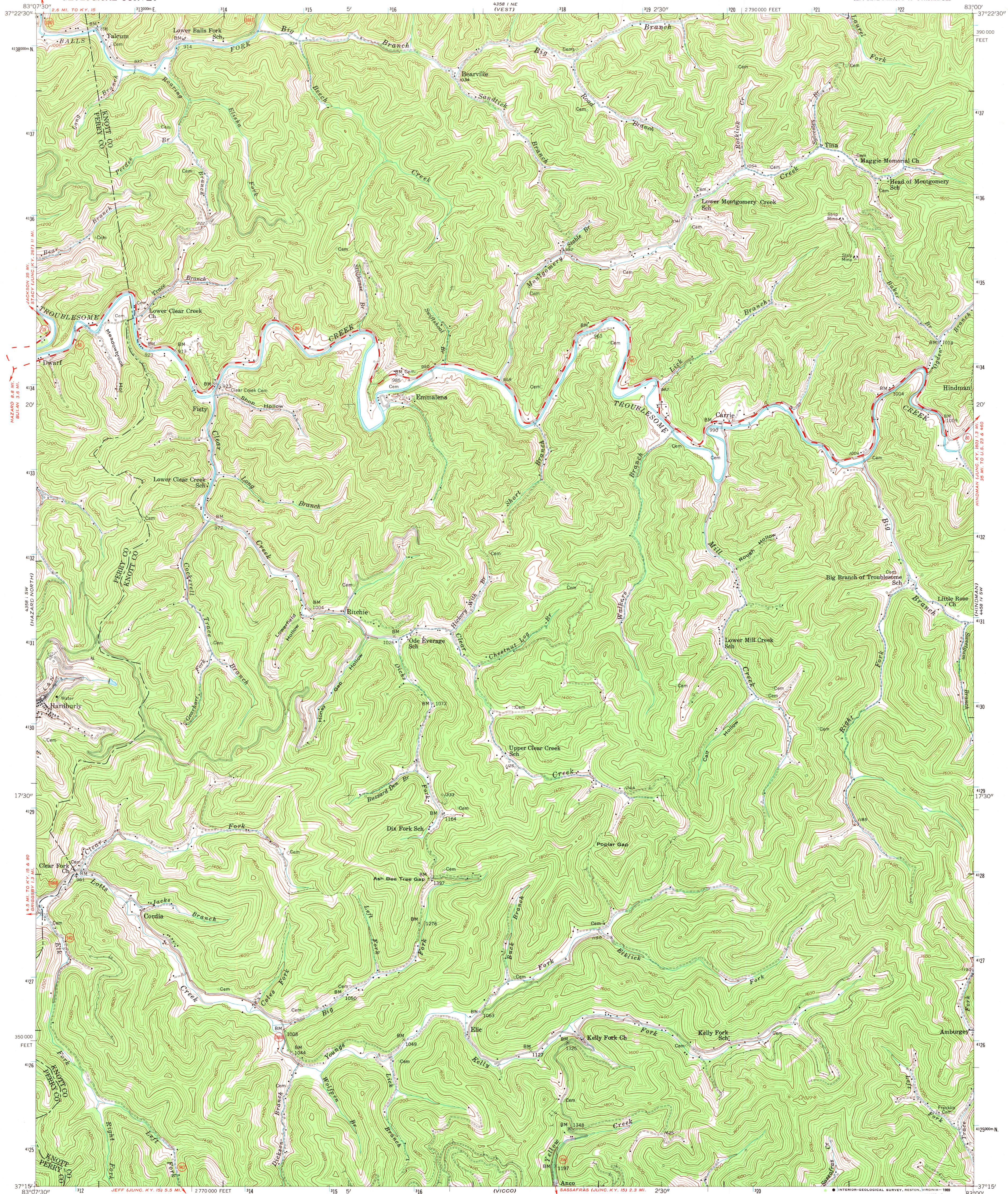

10,000-foot grid based on Kentucky coordinate system, south zone

Contours in strip mine areas from 1952 photography

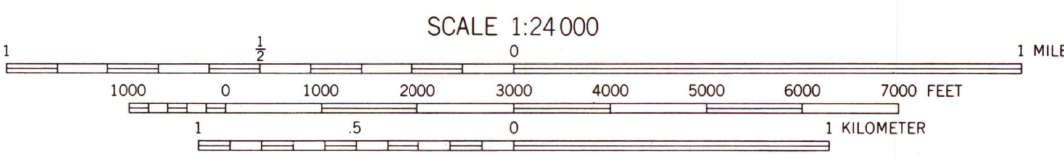
All wells shown are gas wells

Unchecked elevations are shown in brown

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 17, shown in blue

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983, move the projection lines 6 meters south and 10 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks
