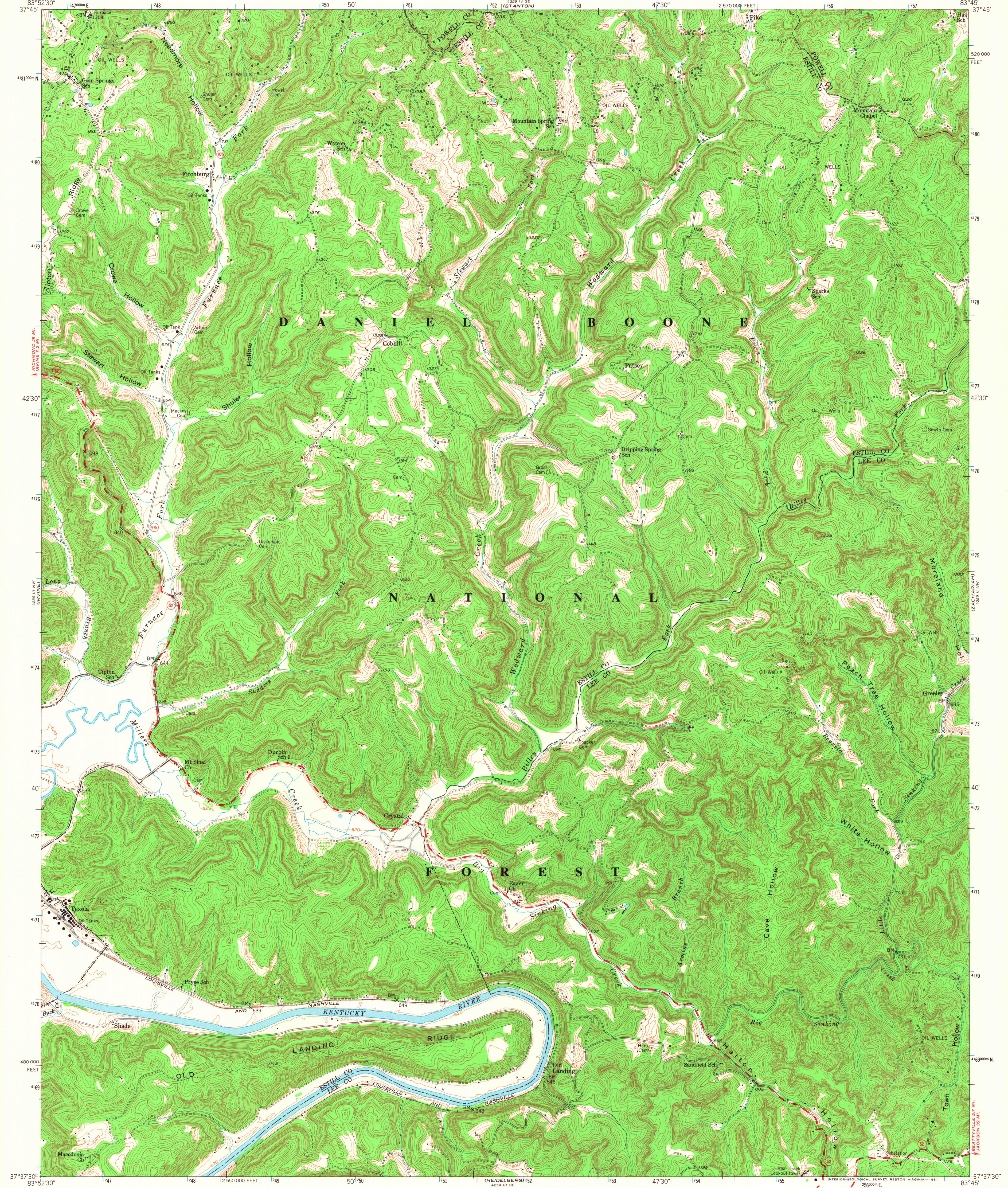

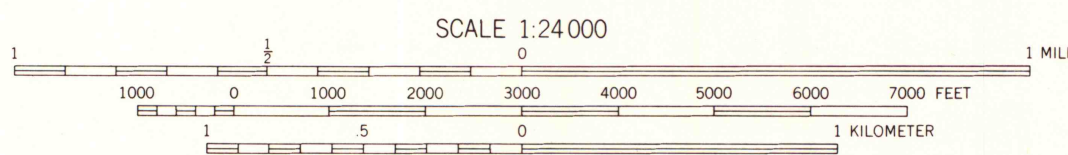
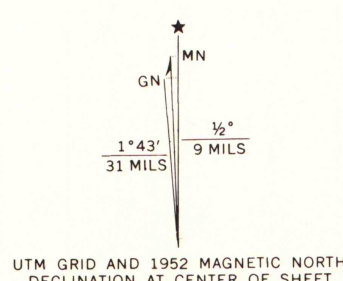

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 5 meters south and 8 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks

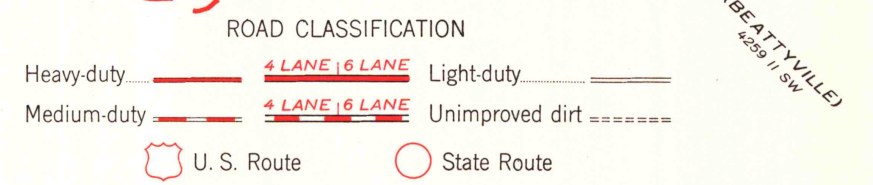
