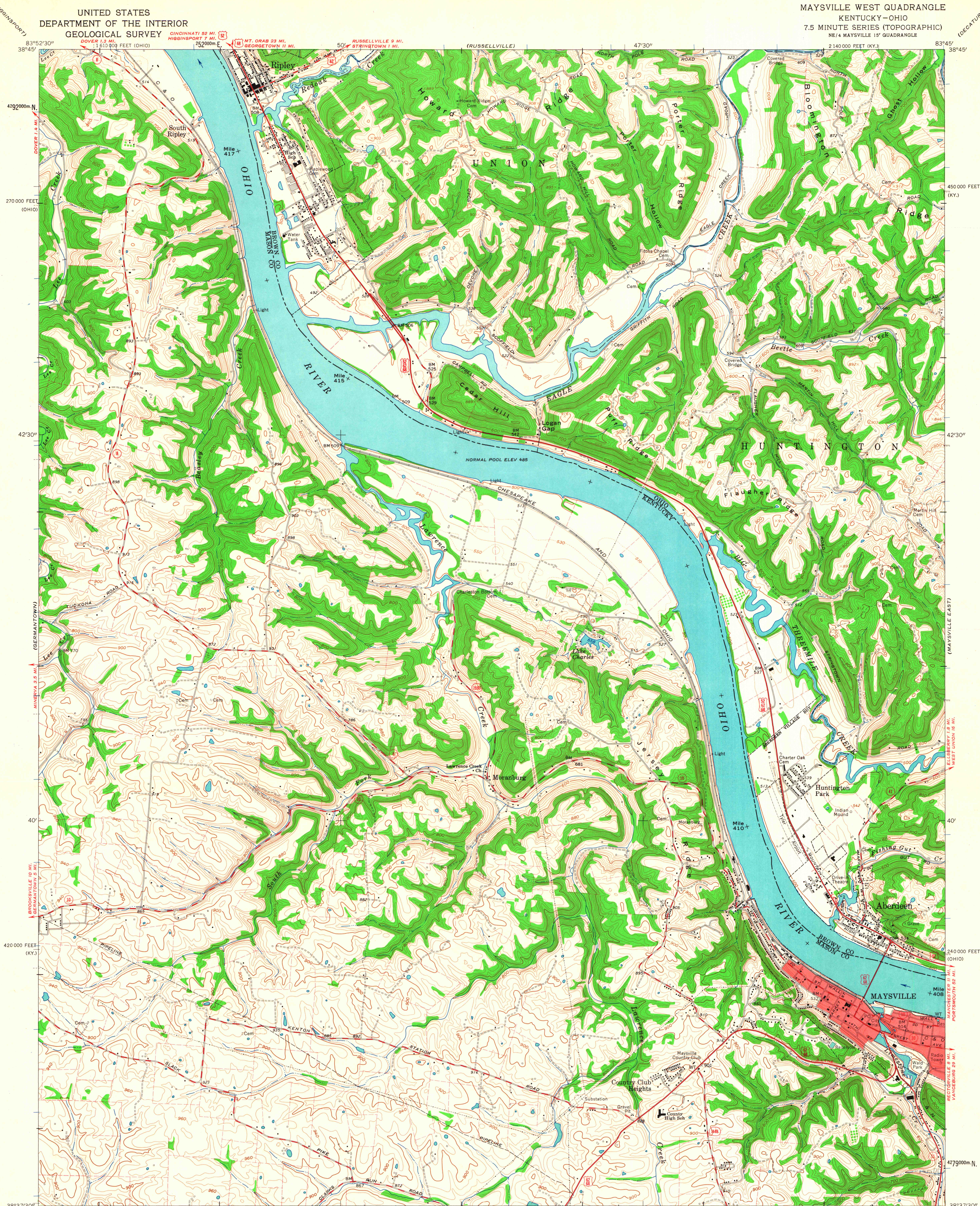

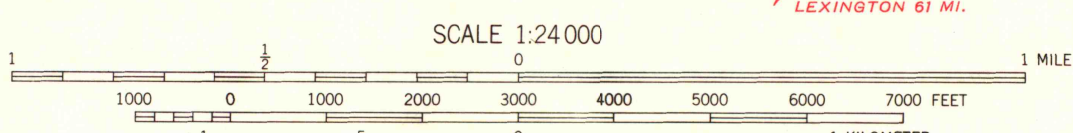
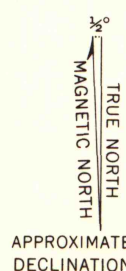

ticks, zone 17, shown in blue

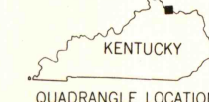
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where
