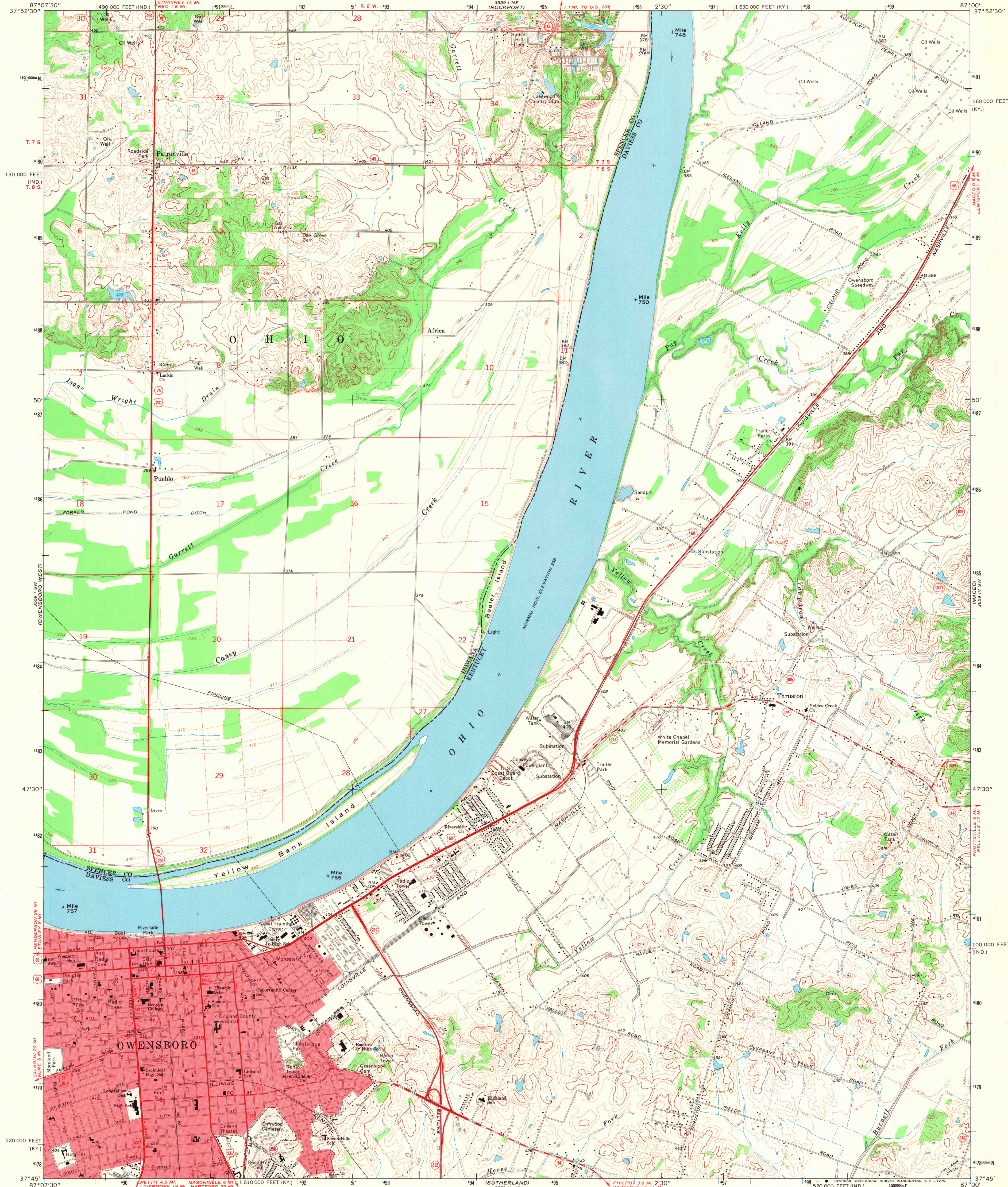


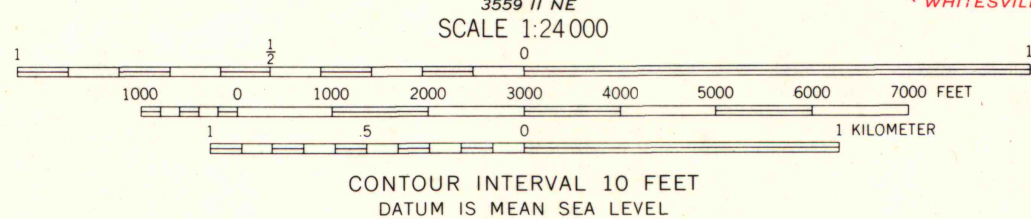

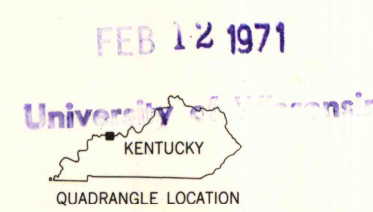
OWENSBORO EAST QUADRANGLE
