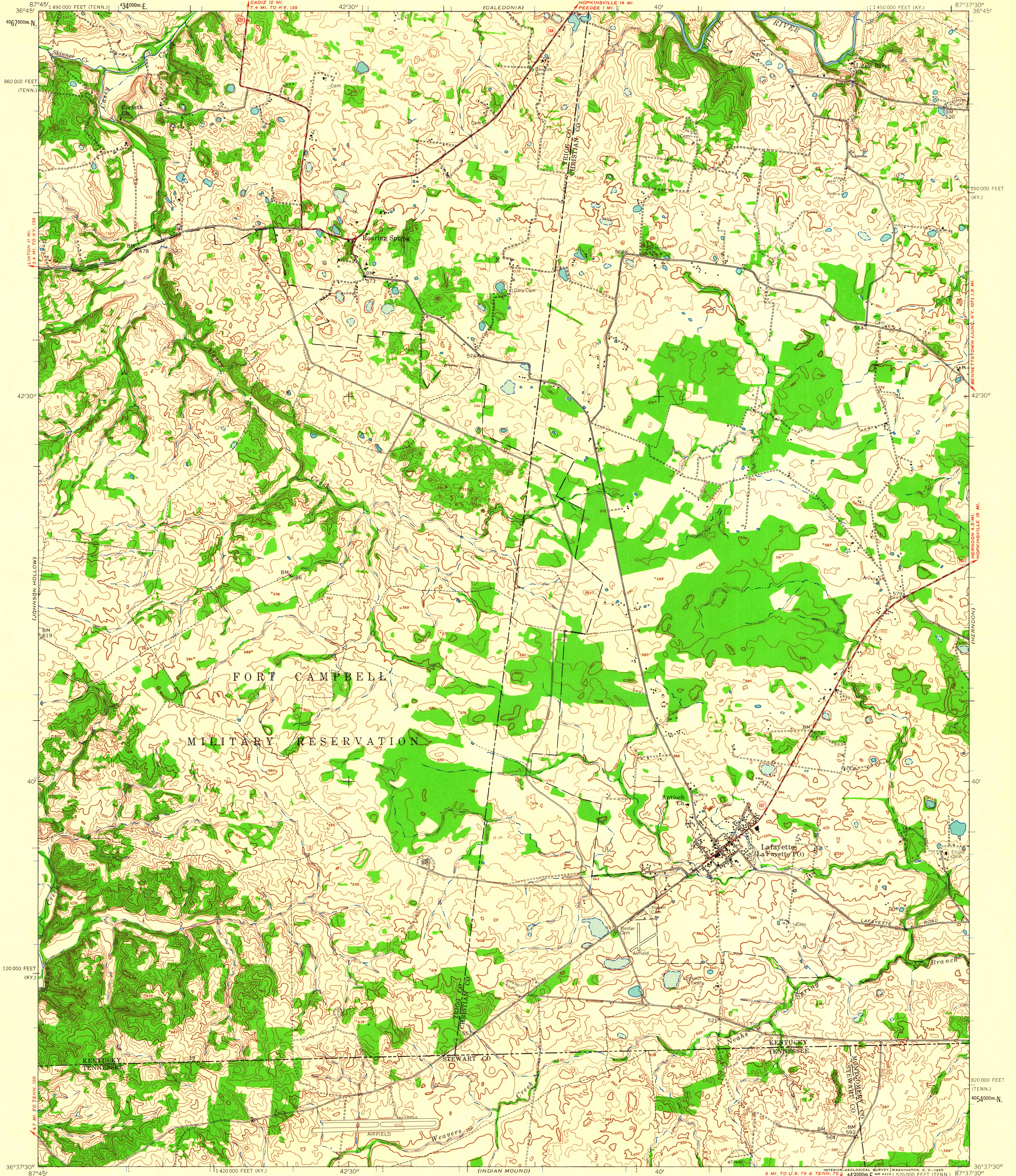


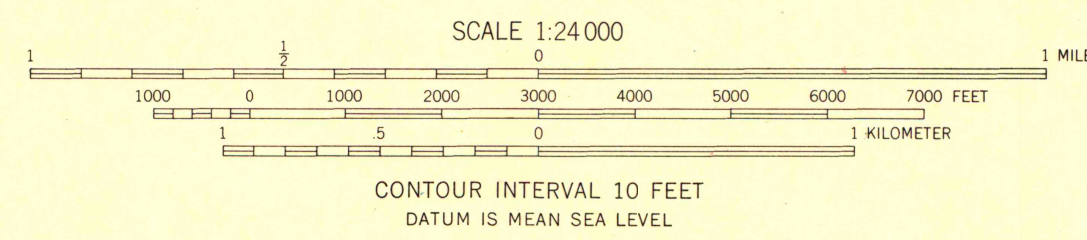

NW 1/4 HERNDON 15' QUADRANGLE

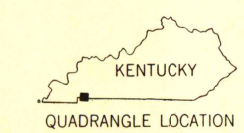
