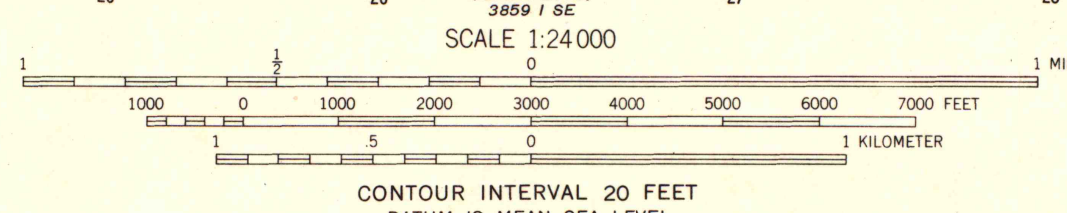

NE 1/4 SHEPHERDSVILLE 15' QUADRANGLE

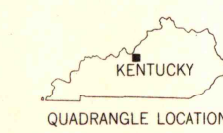
