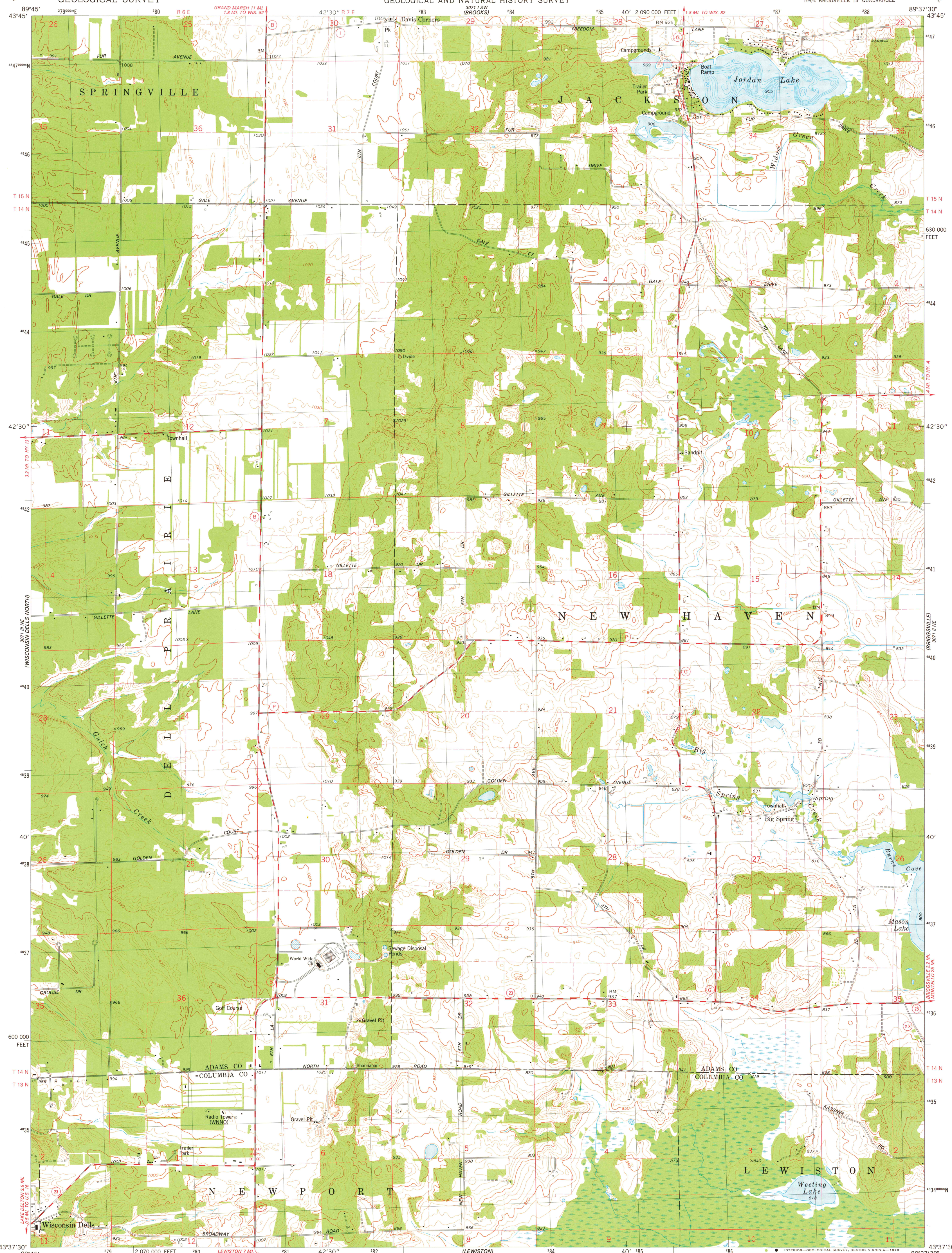


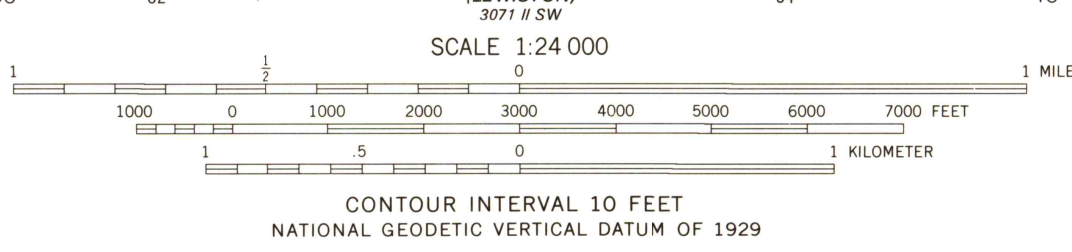

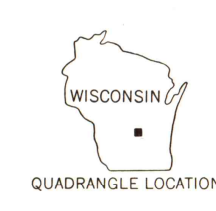
BIG SPRING QUADRANGLE
