

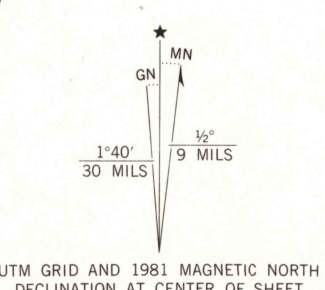

Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1976. Field checked 1978. Map edited 1981. Hydrography compiled from information furnished by Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources. Projection: Wisconsin coordinate system, north zone (Lambert conformal conic). 10,000-foot grid ticks based on Wisconsin coordinate system, north zone, and Michigan coordinate system, north zone. 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid, zone 16 1927 North American Datum. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 6 meters north and 10 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks.
