

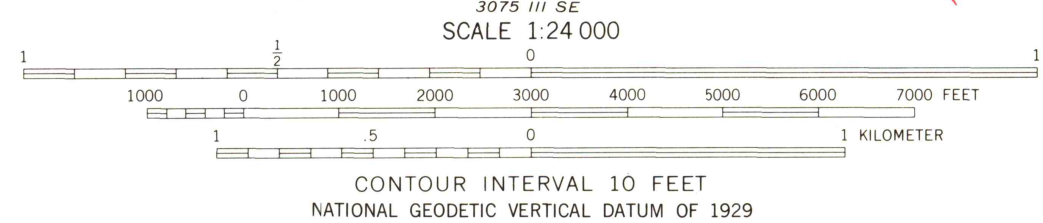

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum. 10,000-foot grid based on Wisconsin coordinate system, north zone. 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 16, shown in blue. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 6 meters north and 10 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks.
