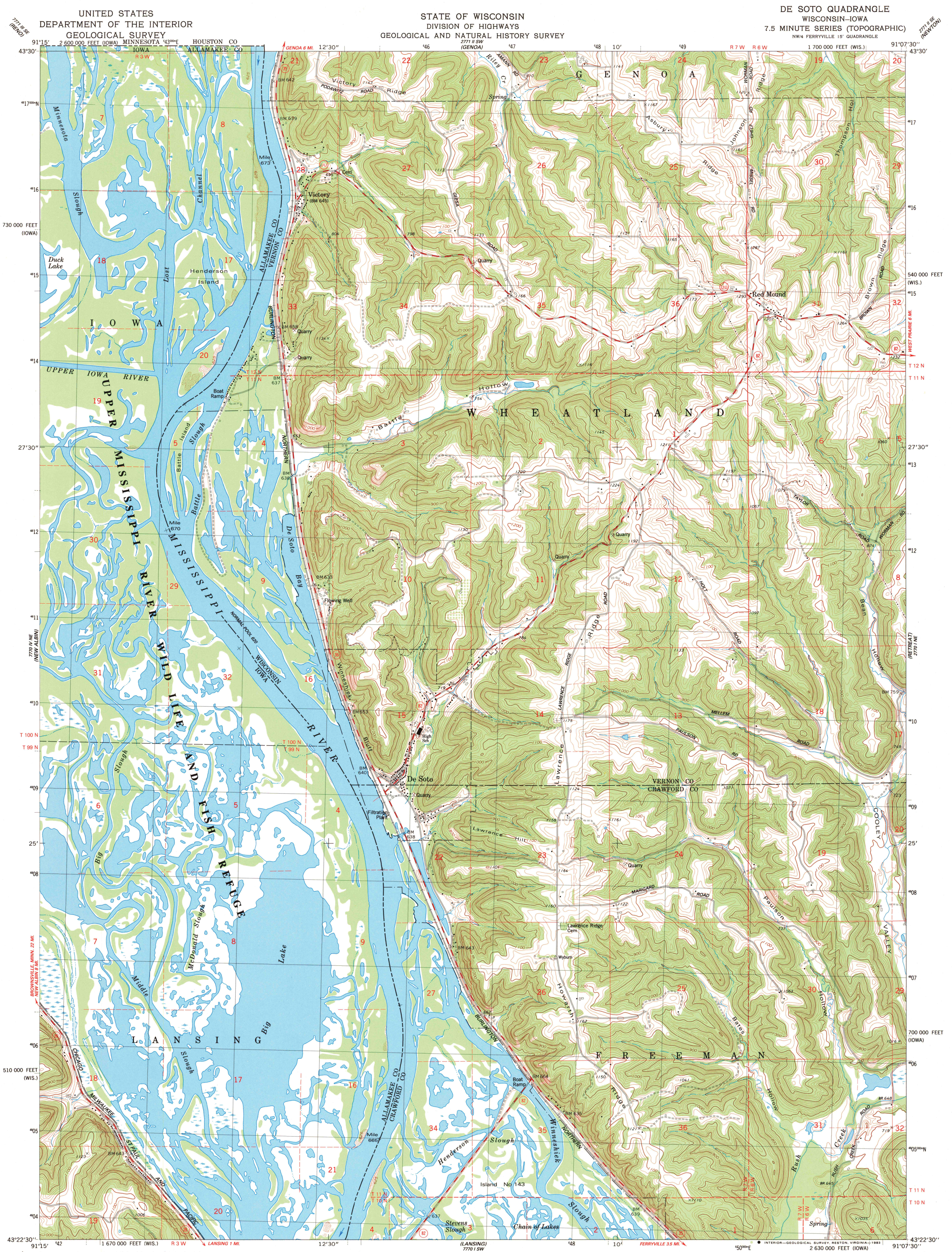

Projection: Wisconsin coordinate system, south zone (Lambert conformal conic). 10,000-foot grid ticks based on Wisconsin coordinate system, south zone and Iowa coordinate system, north zone 15 1927 North American Datum. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 6 meters north and 12 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks. There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map. Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked.
