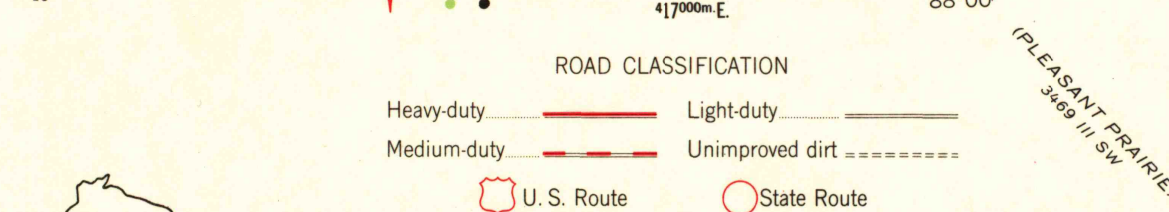
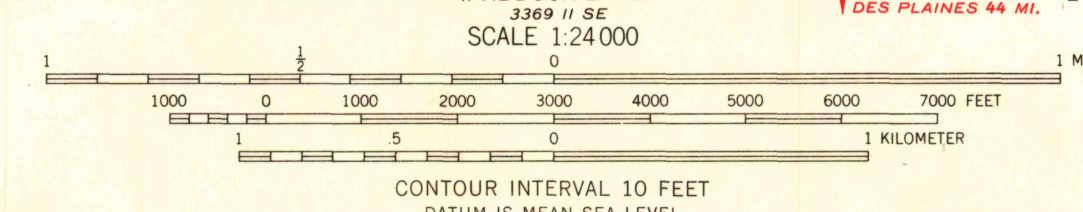
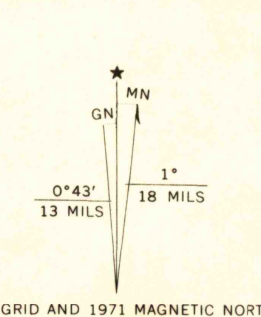
UNION GROVE QUADRANGLE
