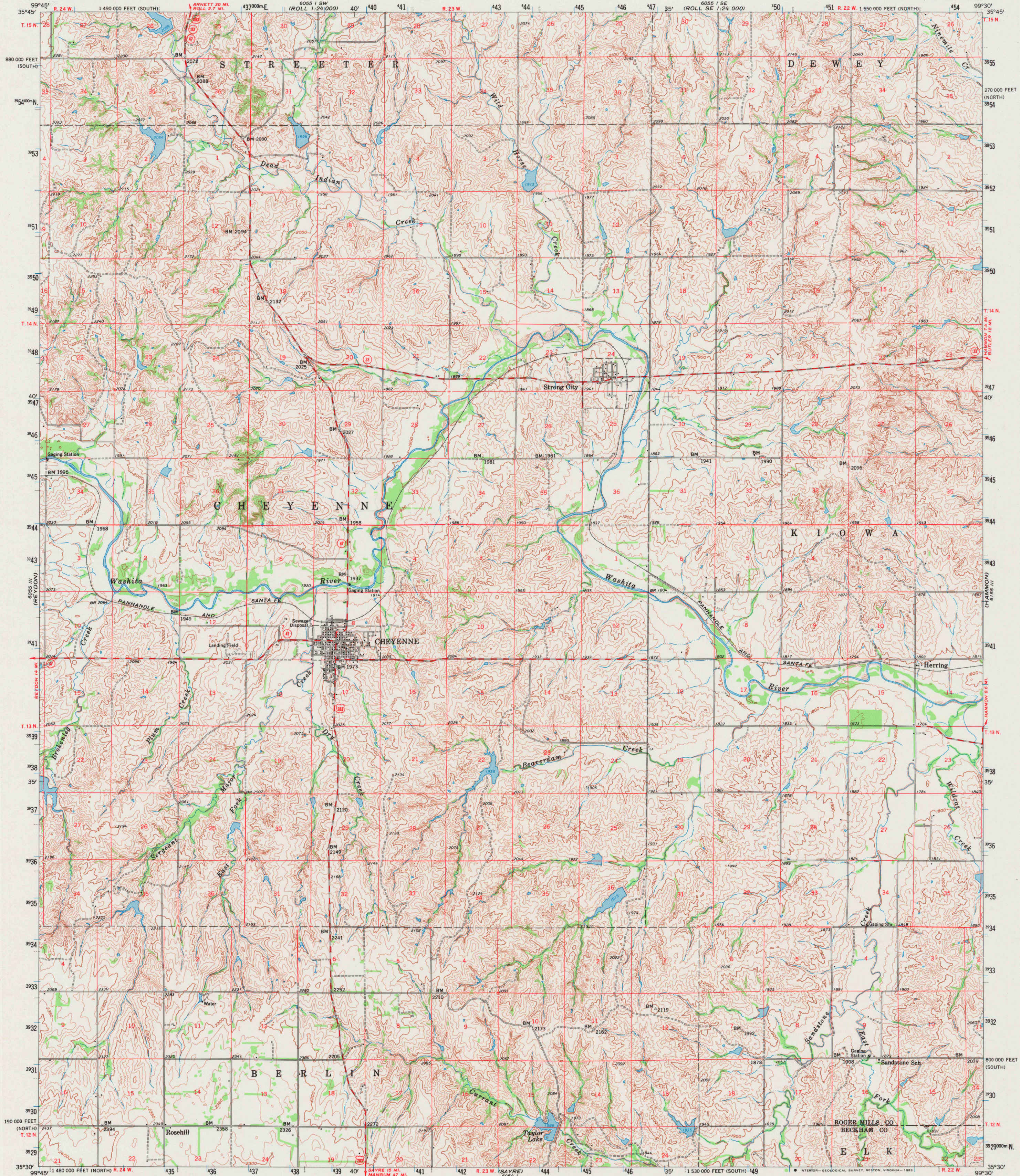
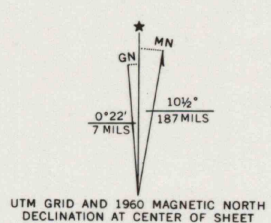

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,
zone 14, shown in blue
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983,
move the projection lines 2 meters south and 34 meters east
