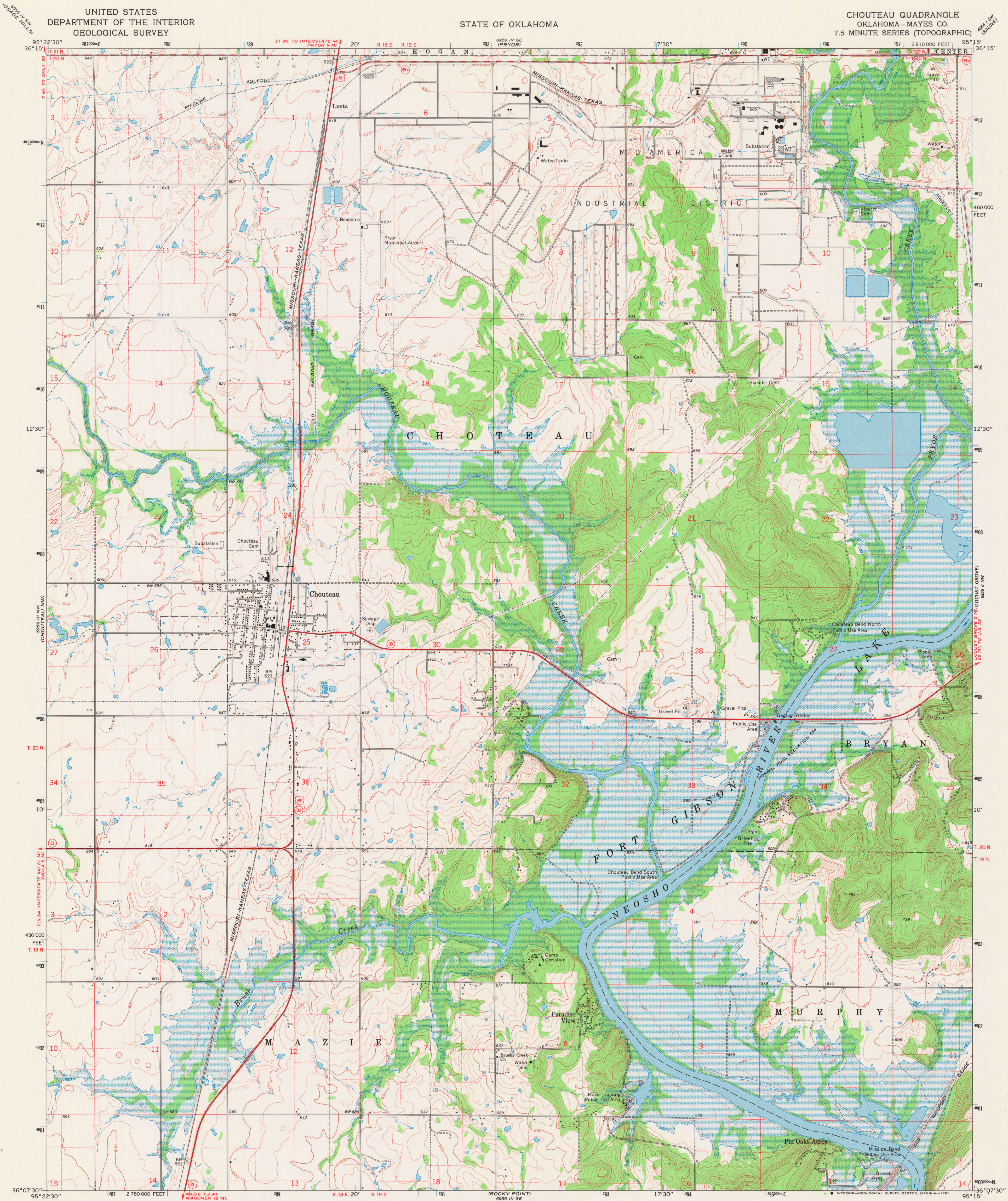

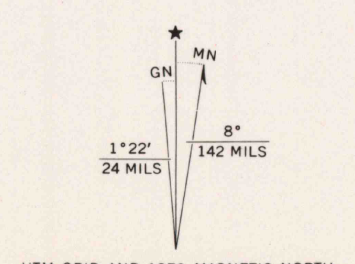

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 4 meters south and 21 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

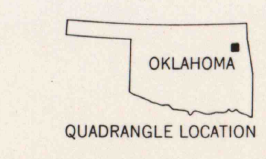
