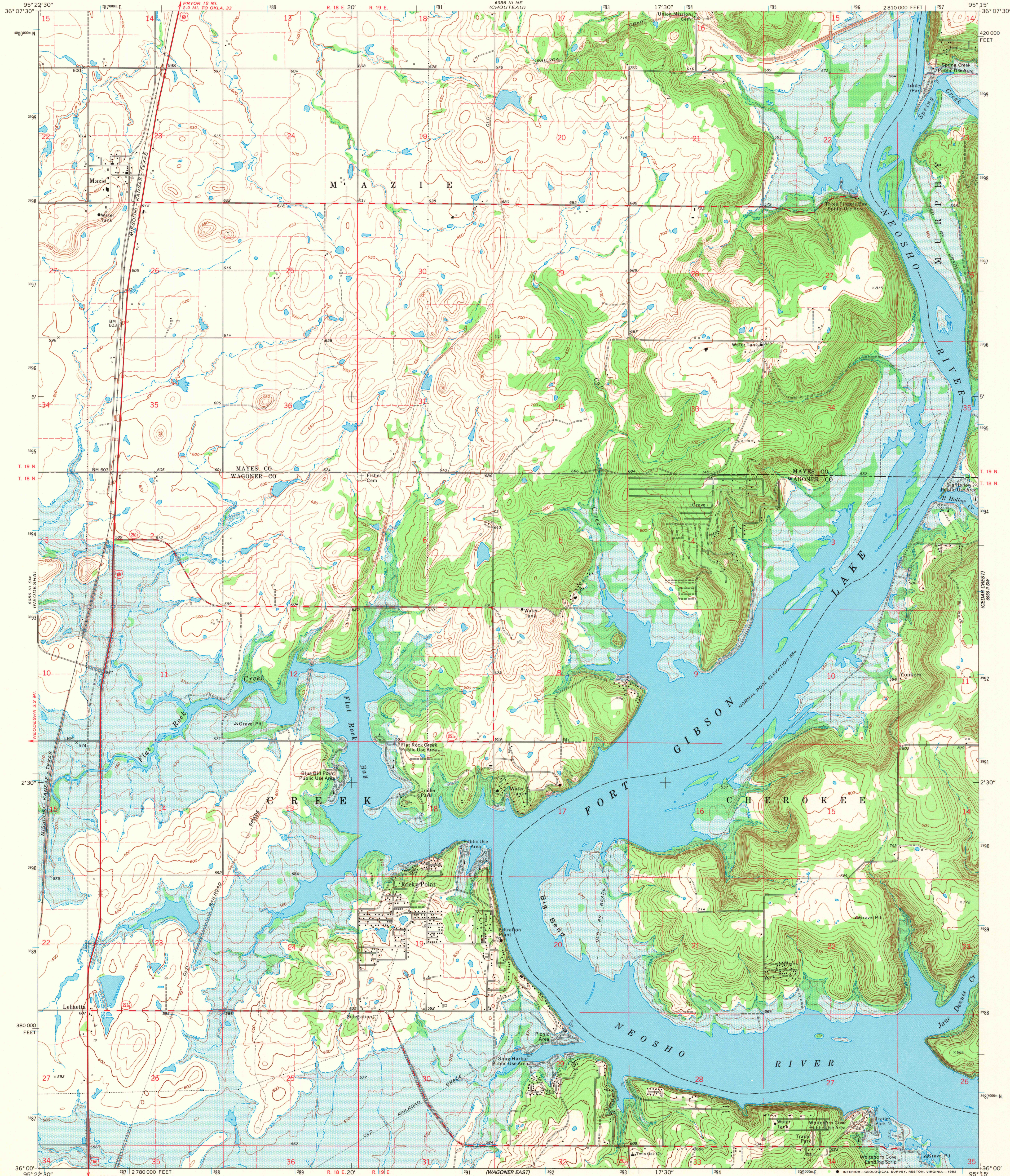

move the projection lines 4 meters south and
21 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
