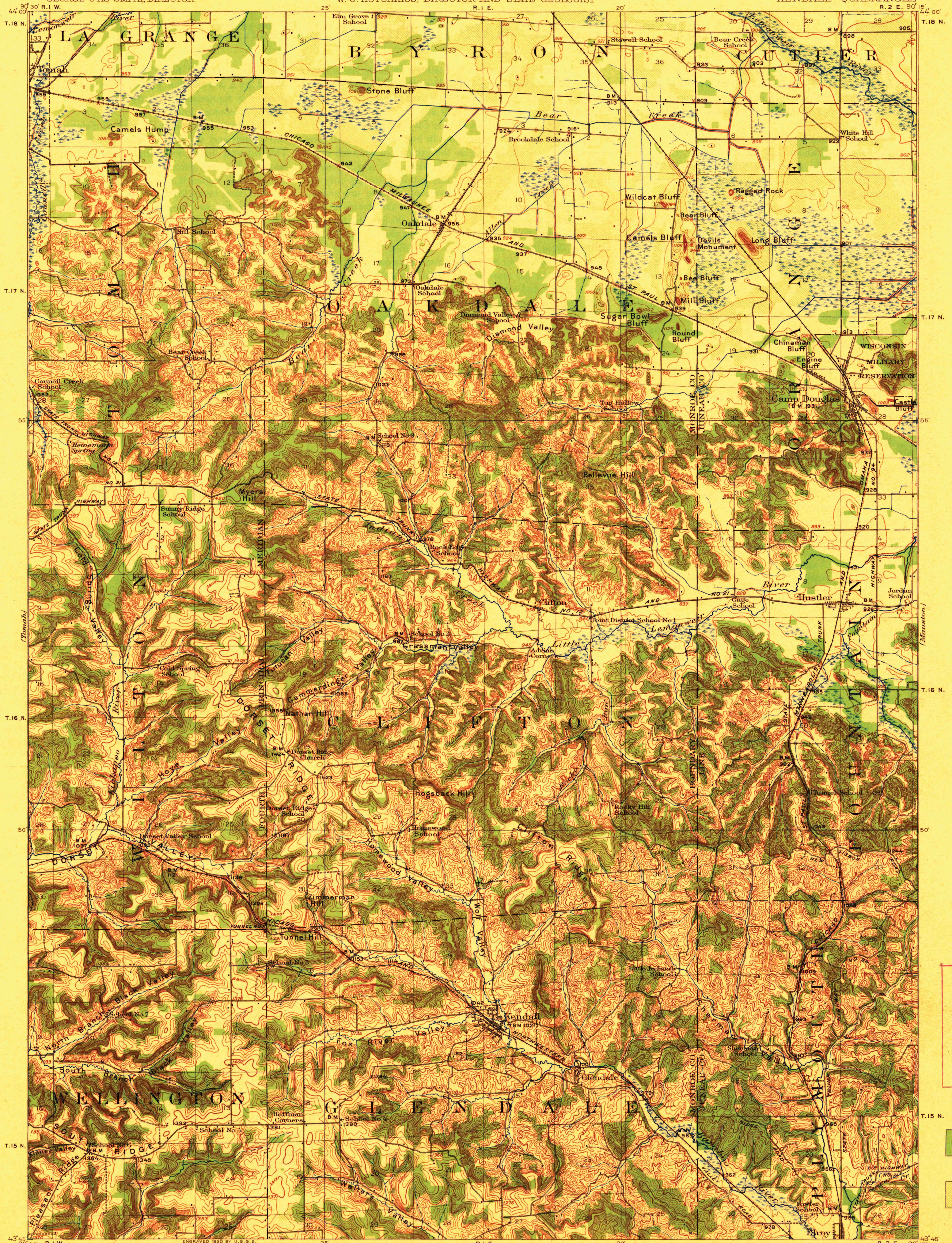


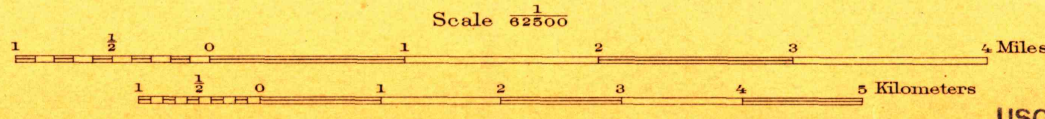

KENDALL QUADRANGLE

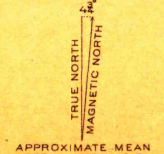
