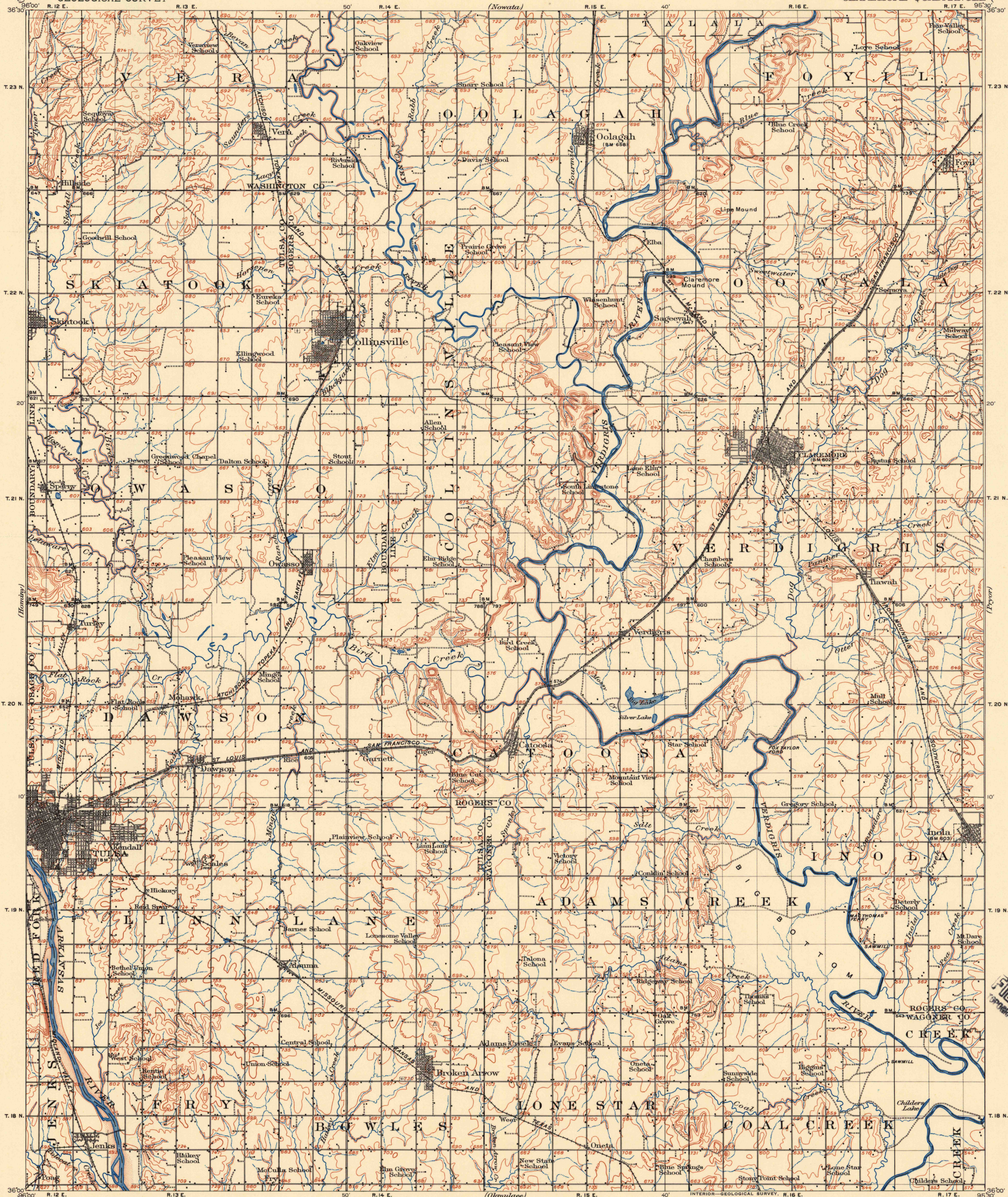

DECLINATION 1914.

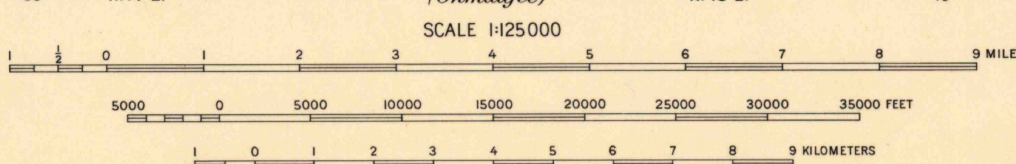


DIAGRAM OF TOWNSHIP
