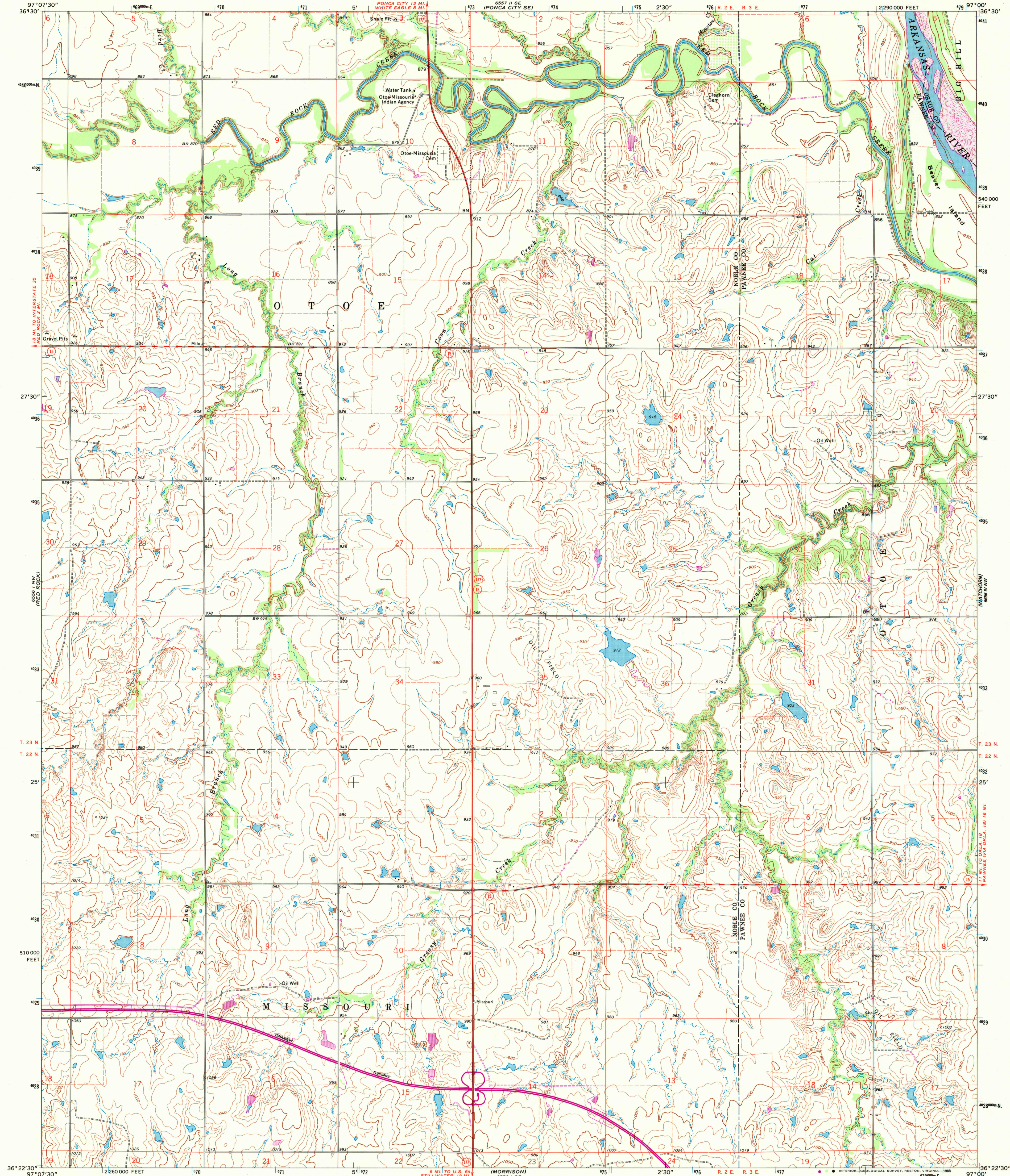

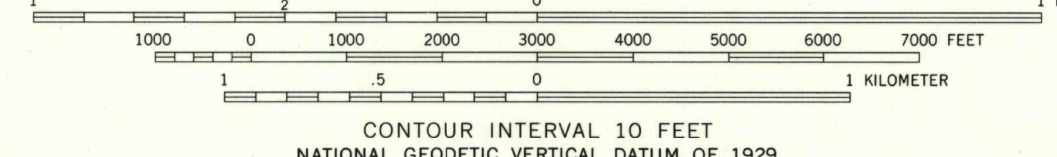
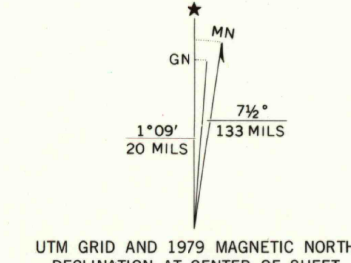
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,

aerial photographs taken 1976 and other source data

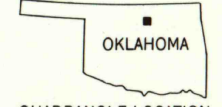
