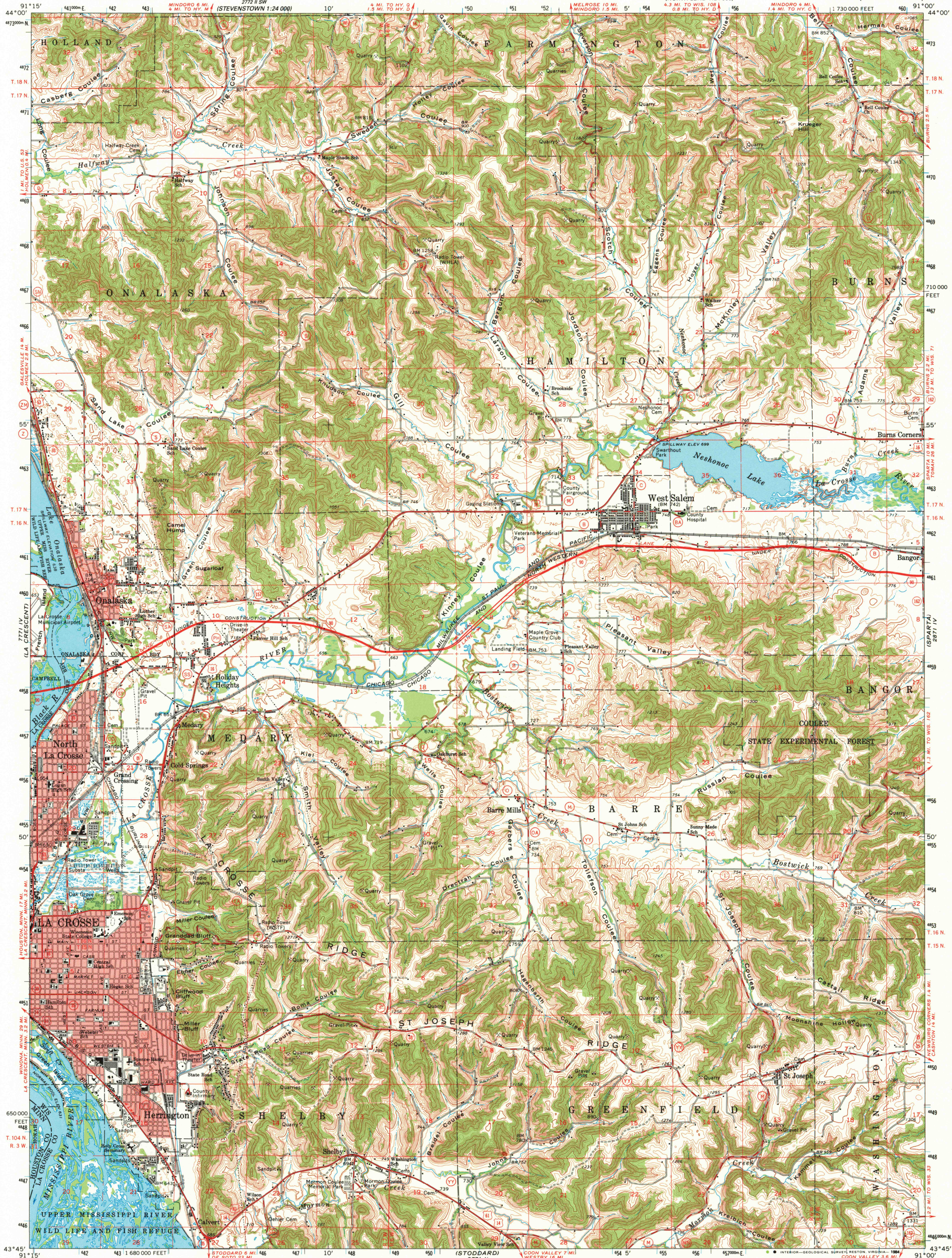

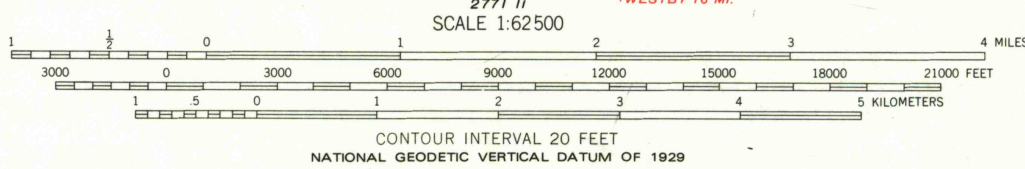
LA CROSSE QUADRANGLE
