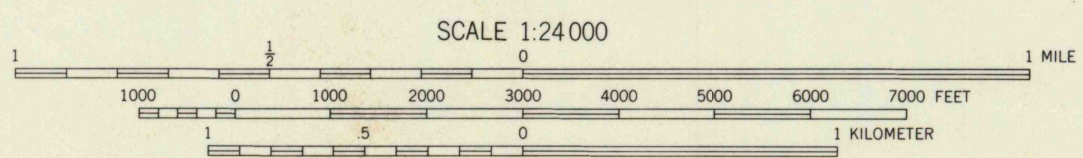

zone 16, shown in blue

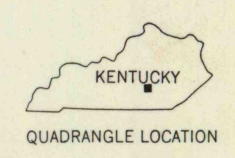
UTM GRID AND 1982 MAGNETIC NORTH
