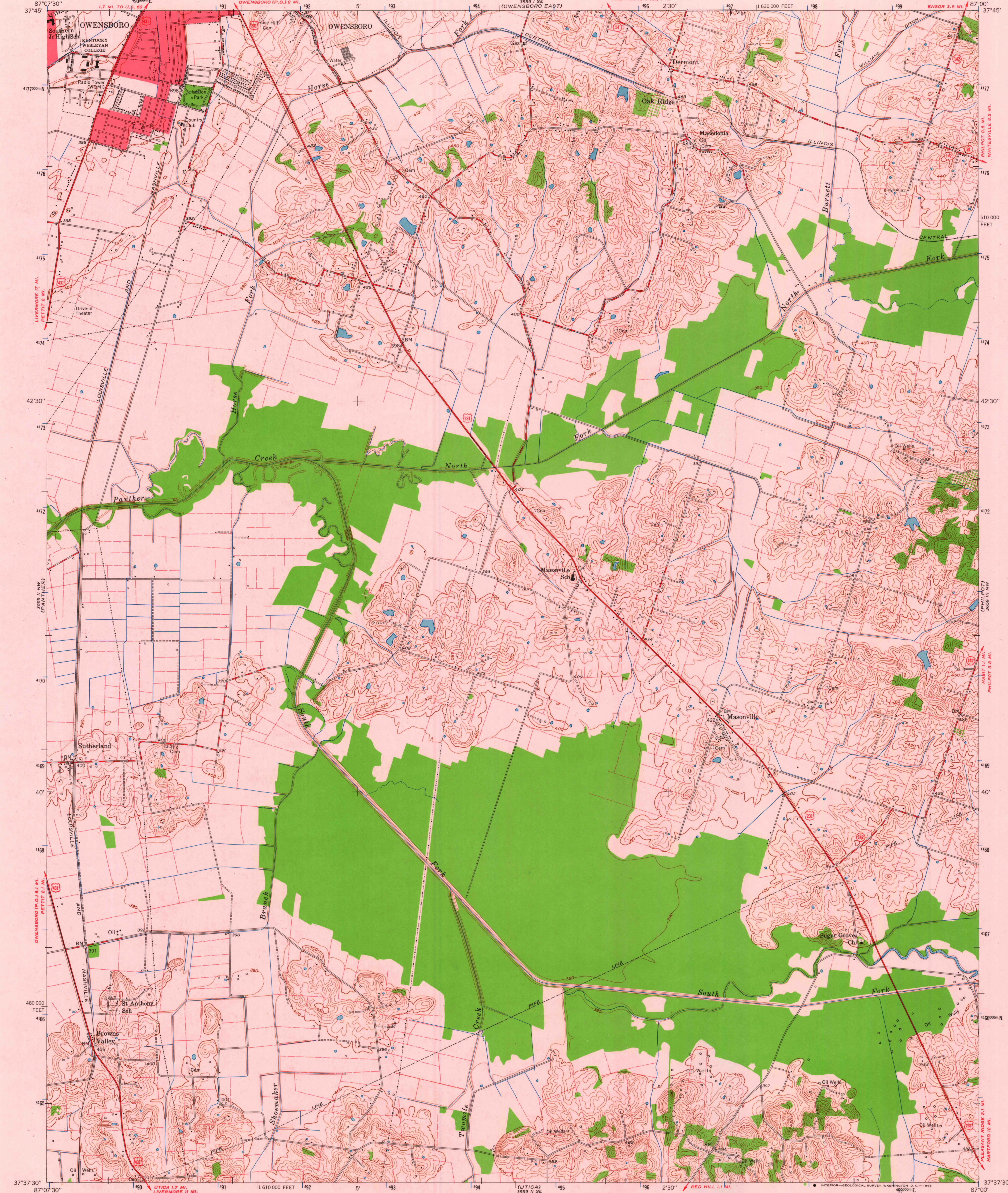

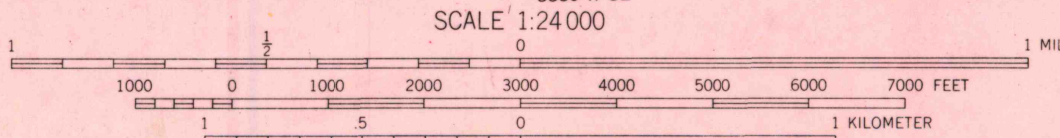
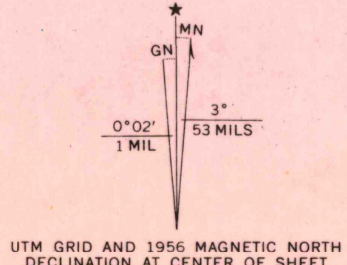

landmark buildings are shown

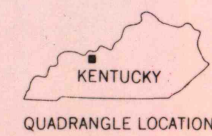
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines
