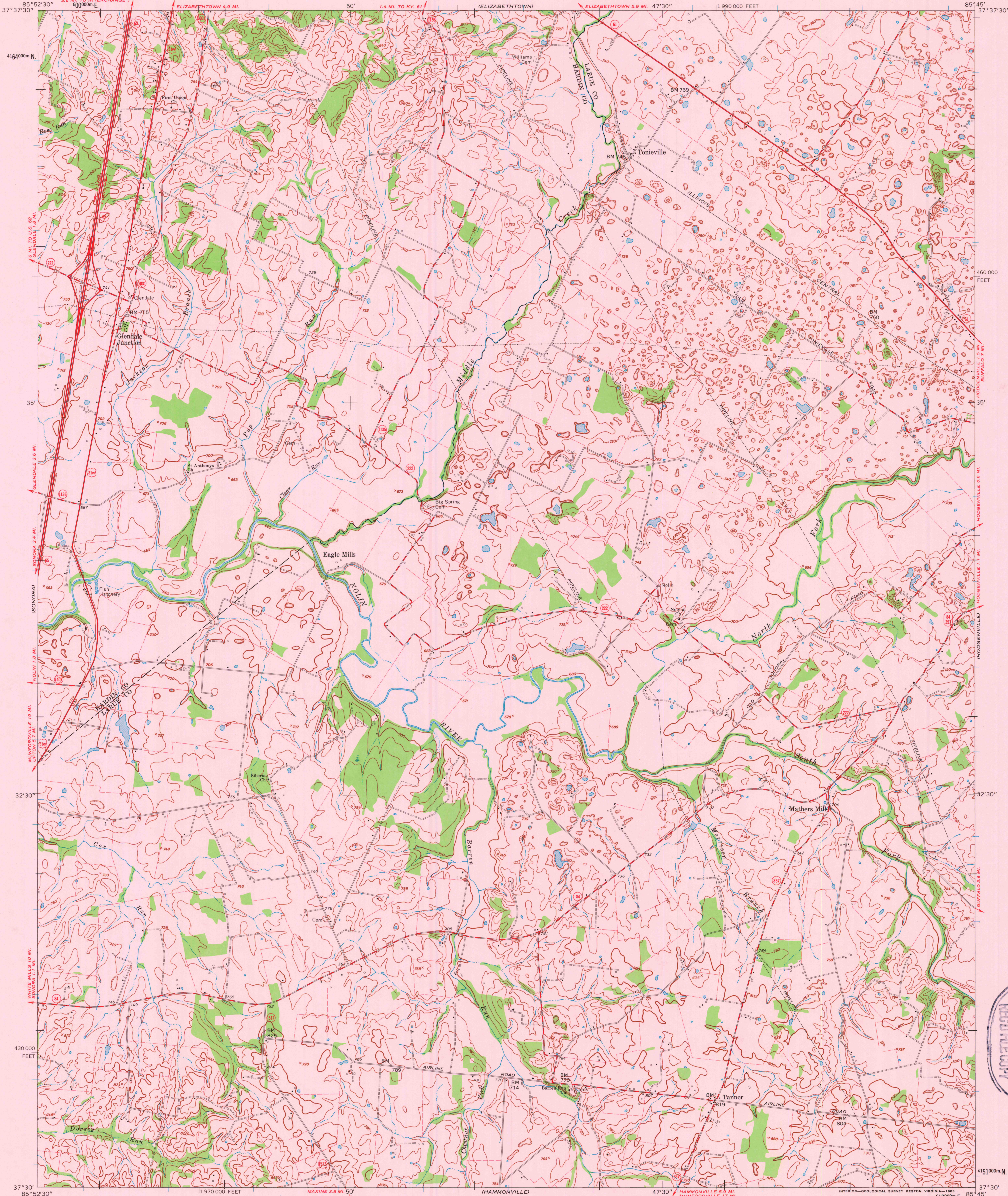

SE/4 ELIZABETHTOWN 15' QUADRANGLE

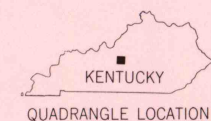
