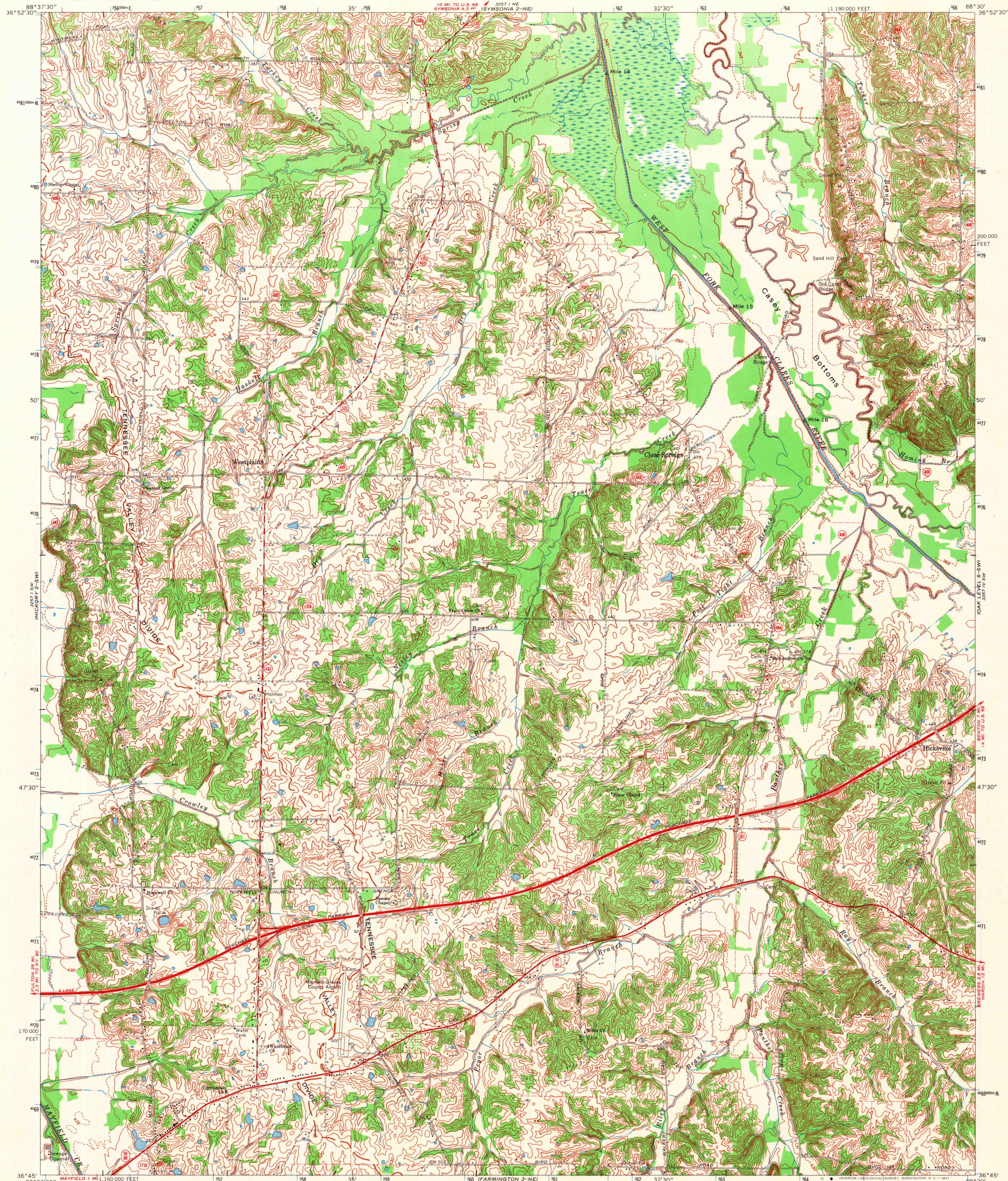

SE/4 HICKORY 15' QUADRANGLE

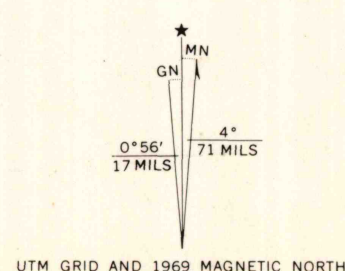

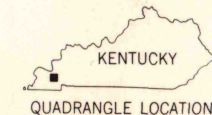
