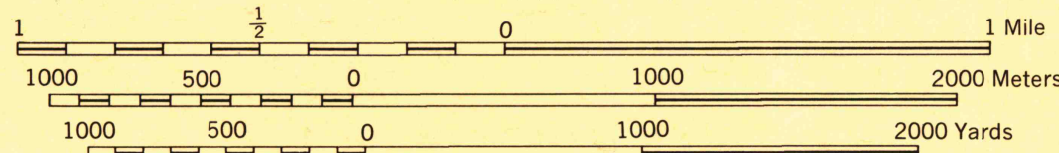

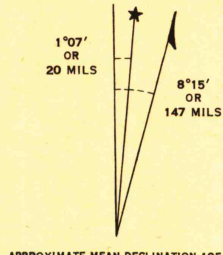

UA	1. Locate first VERTICAL grid line to LEFT of point and read LARGE figures labeling the line either in the top or bottom margin, or on the line itself: Estimate tenths from grid line to point: 2. Locate first HORIZONTAL grid line BELOW point and read LARGE figures labeling the line either in the left or right margin, or on the line itself: Estimate tenths from grid line to point:
IGNORE THE SMALLER figures of any grid number; these are for finding the full coordinates. Use ONLY the LARGER figures of the grid number; example: 5022000	78 4 87 7

	If reporting beyond 100,000 meters or if sheet bears an overlapping grid, prefix 100,000 Meter Square Identification as: UA78877
	If reporting beyond 18" in any direction, prefix Grid Zone Designation as: 15TUA78877

FOR CENTER OF SHEET
ANNUAL MAGNETIC CHANGE 2" WESTERLY
Use diagram only to obtain numerical values.
To determine magnetic north line, connect the
pivot point "P" on the south edge of the map
with the value of the angle between GRID
NORTH and MAGNETIC NORTH, as plotted on
the degree scale at the north edge of the map.
