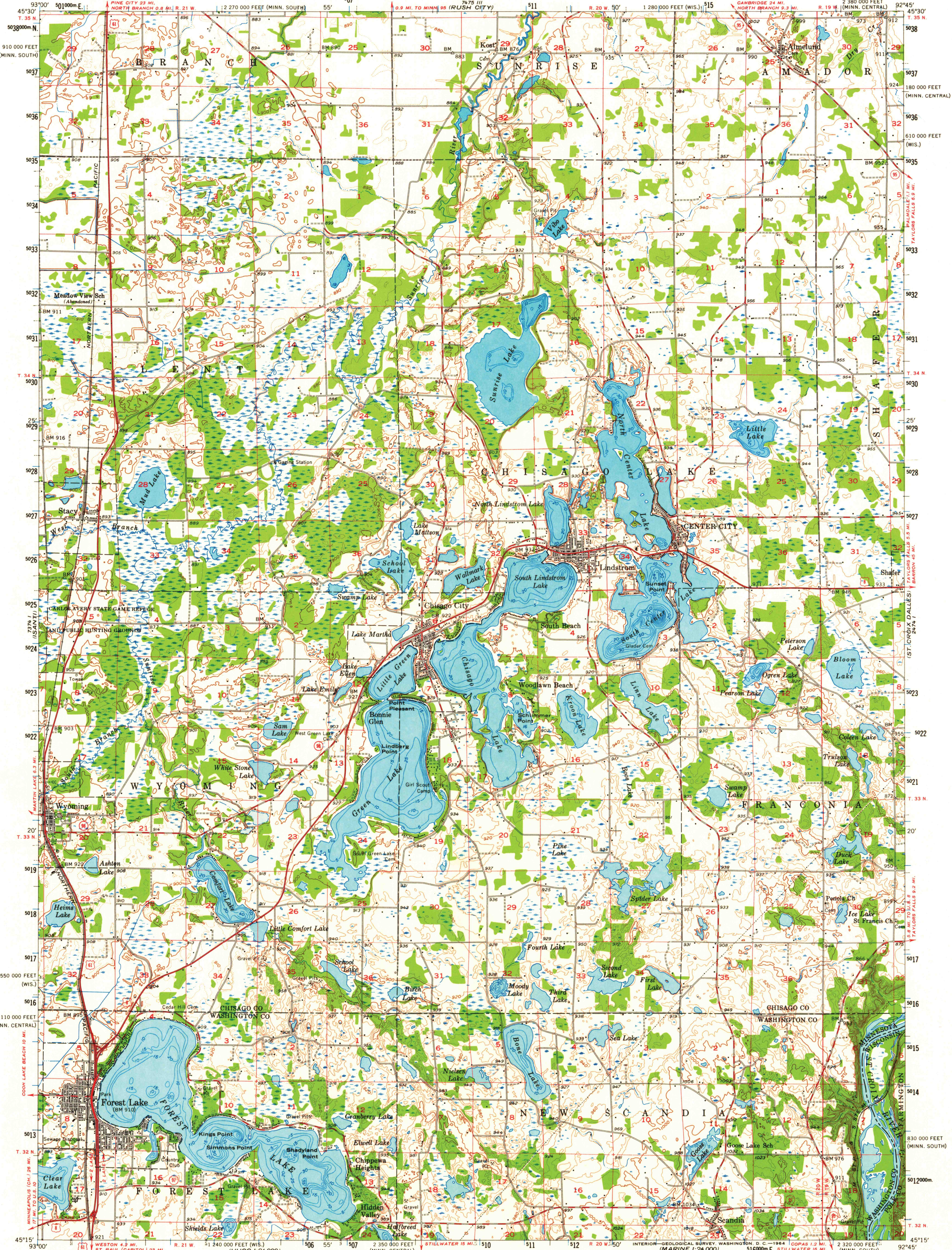

central and south zones, and Wisconsin coordinate system,

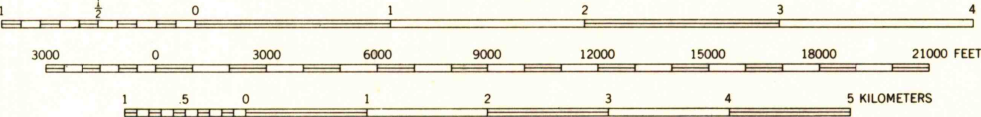
central zone
