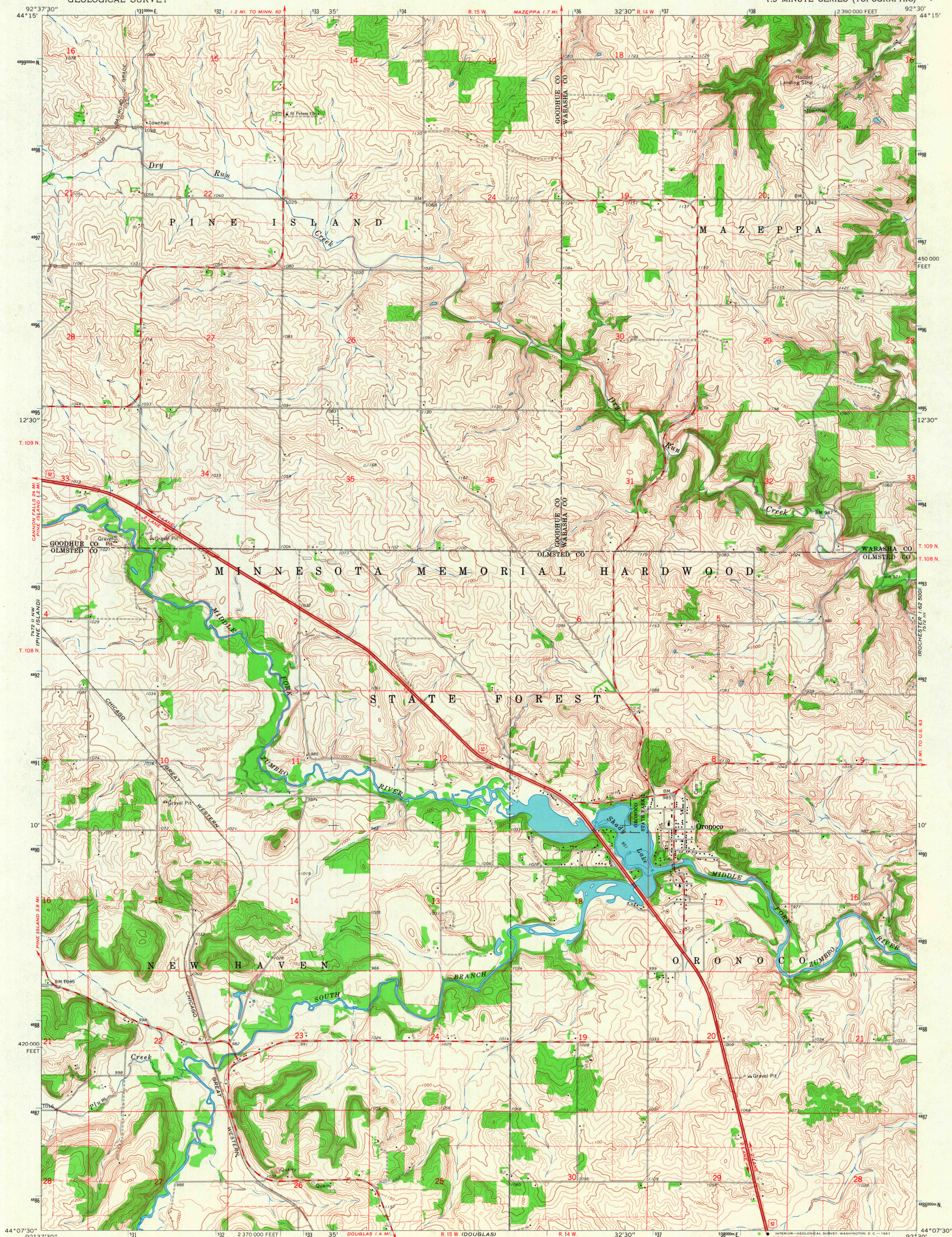

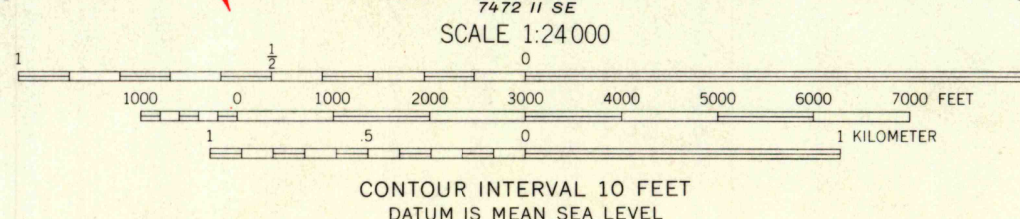
Depth curves compiled from charts furnished by Minnesota Department of Conservation
