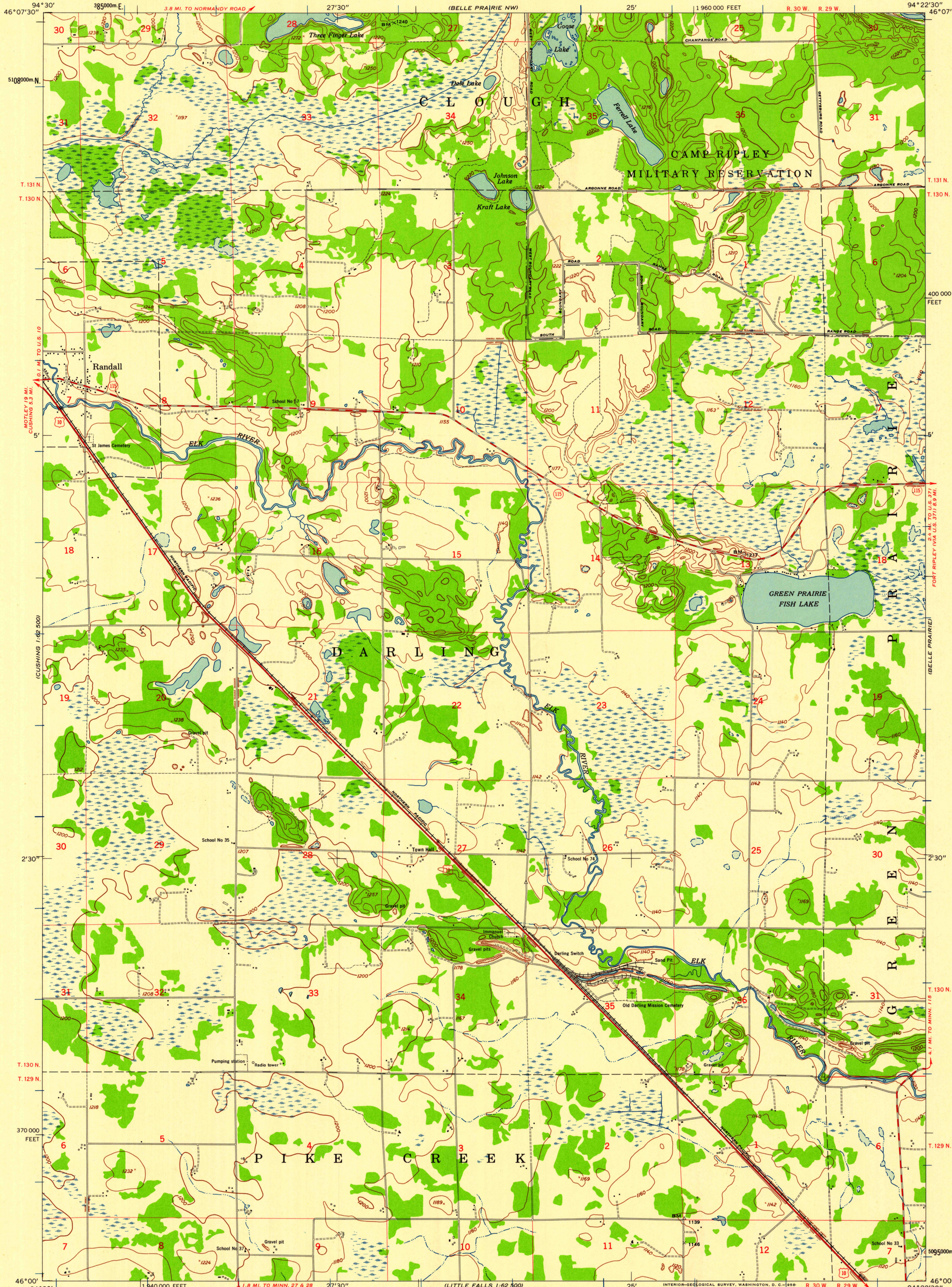

SW/4 BELLE PRAIRIE 15' QUADRANGLE

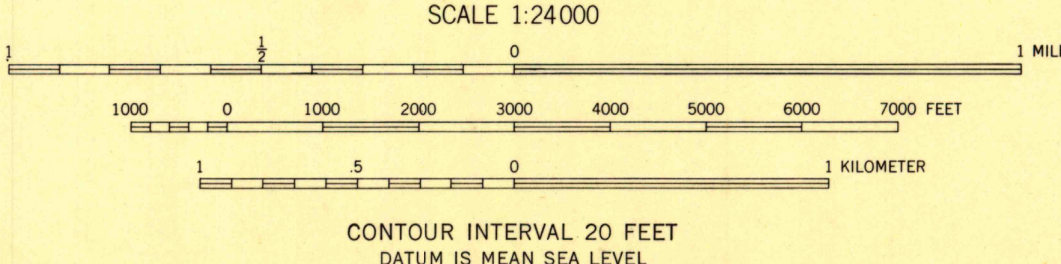
