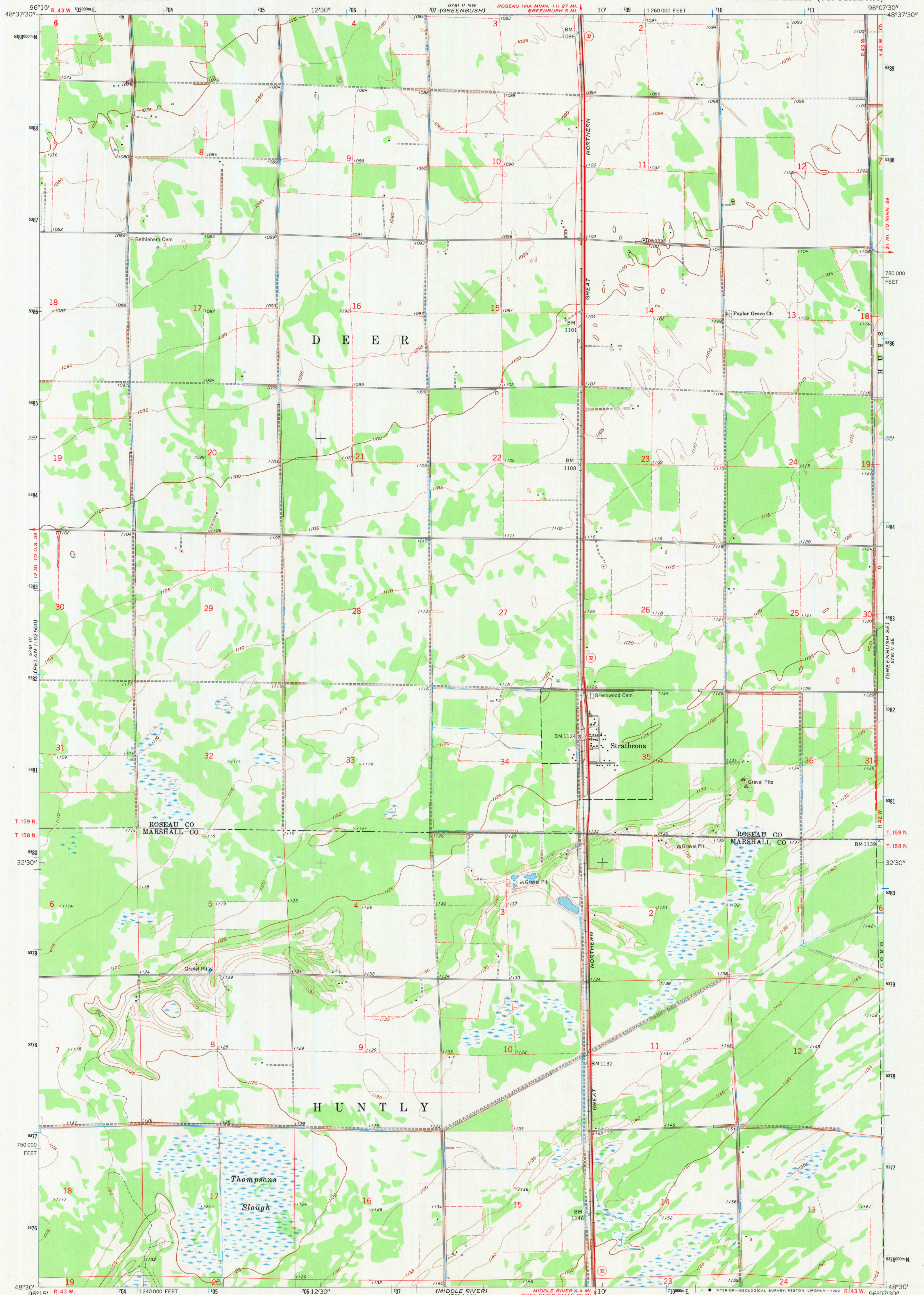

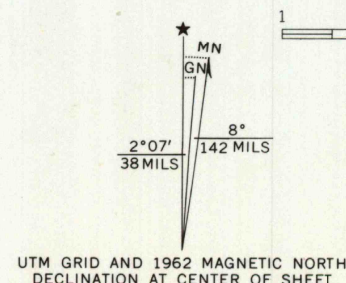

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grid based on Minnesota coordinate system, north zone 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 14, shown in blue

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 5 meters north and 22 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked
