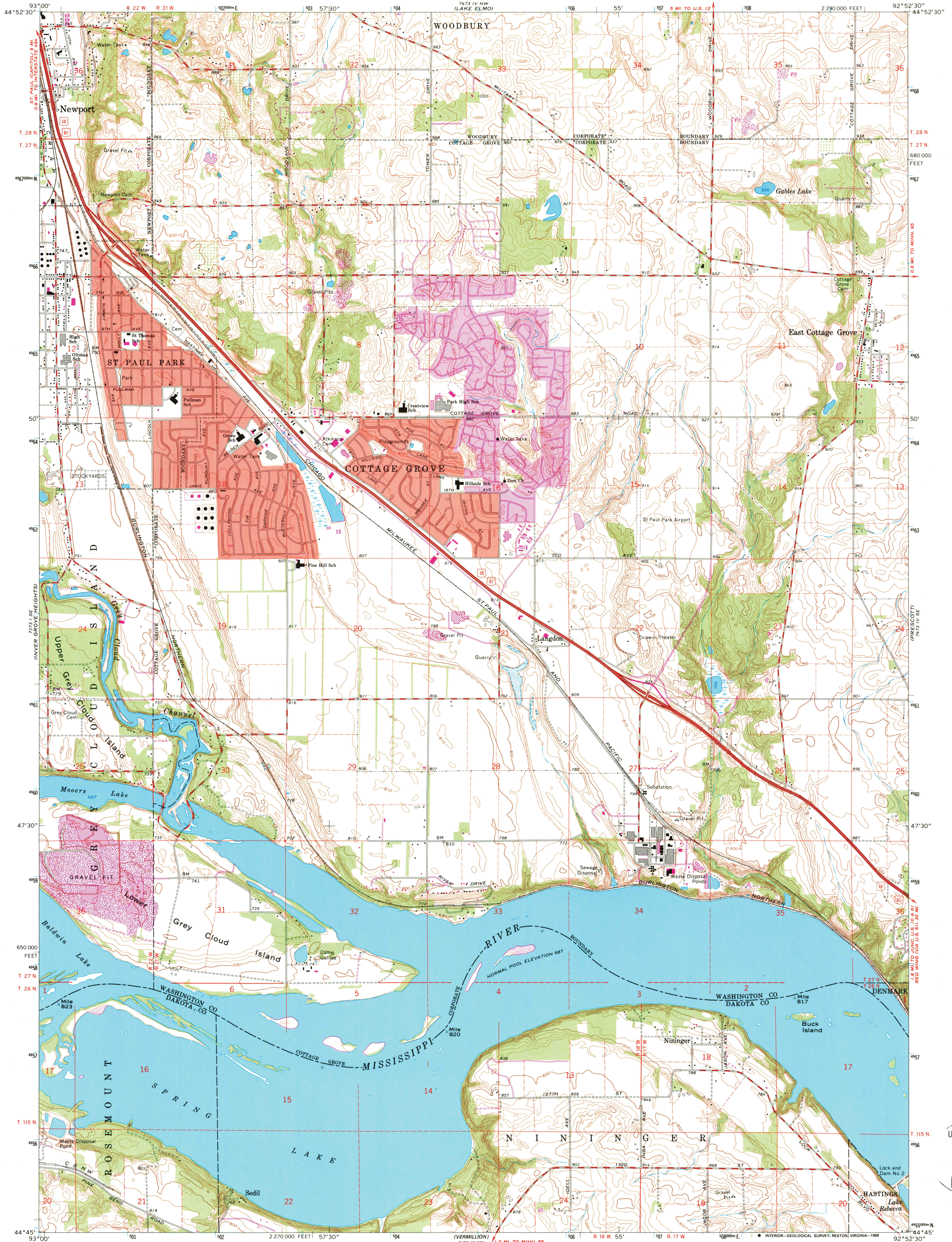
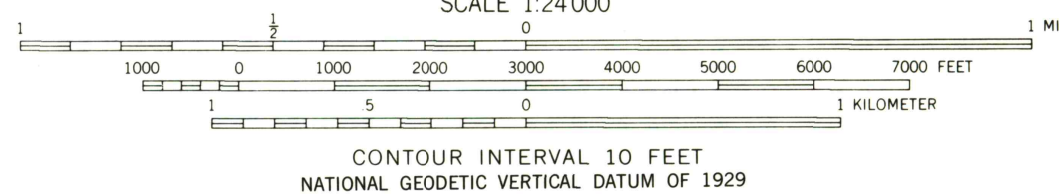

Field checked 1967 Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grid based on Minnesota coordinate system, south zone 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 15, shown in blue Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 7 meters north and 17 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
