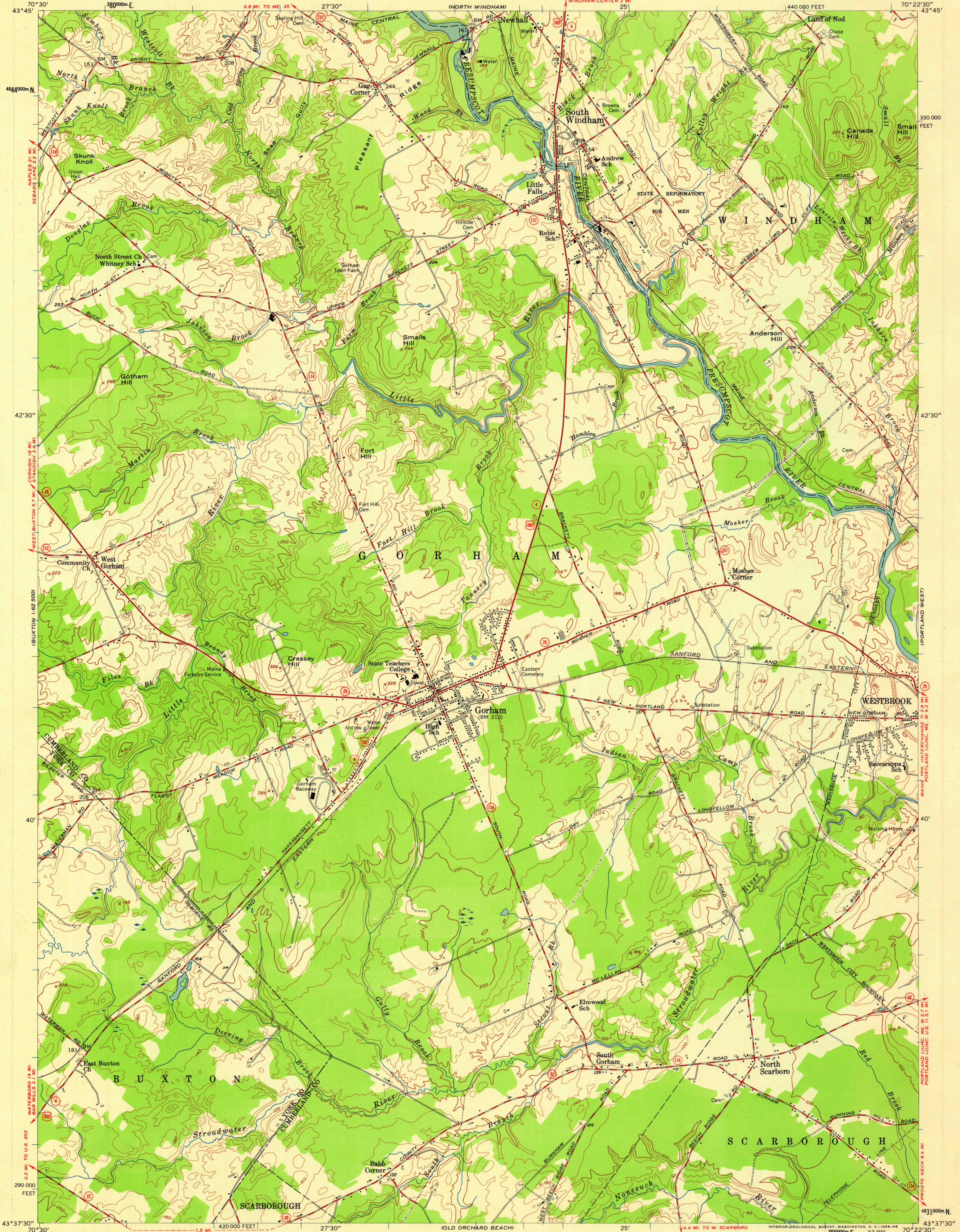

NW/4 PORTLAND 15' QUADRANGLE



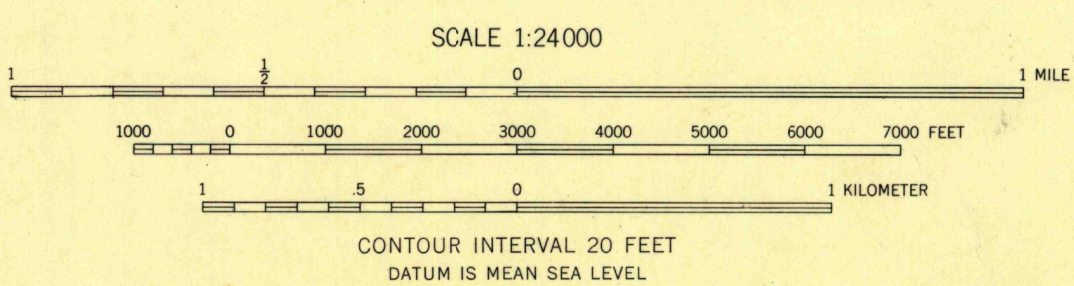

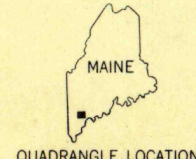
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum
