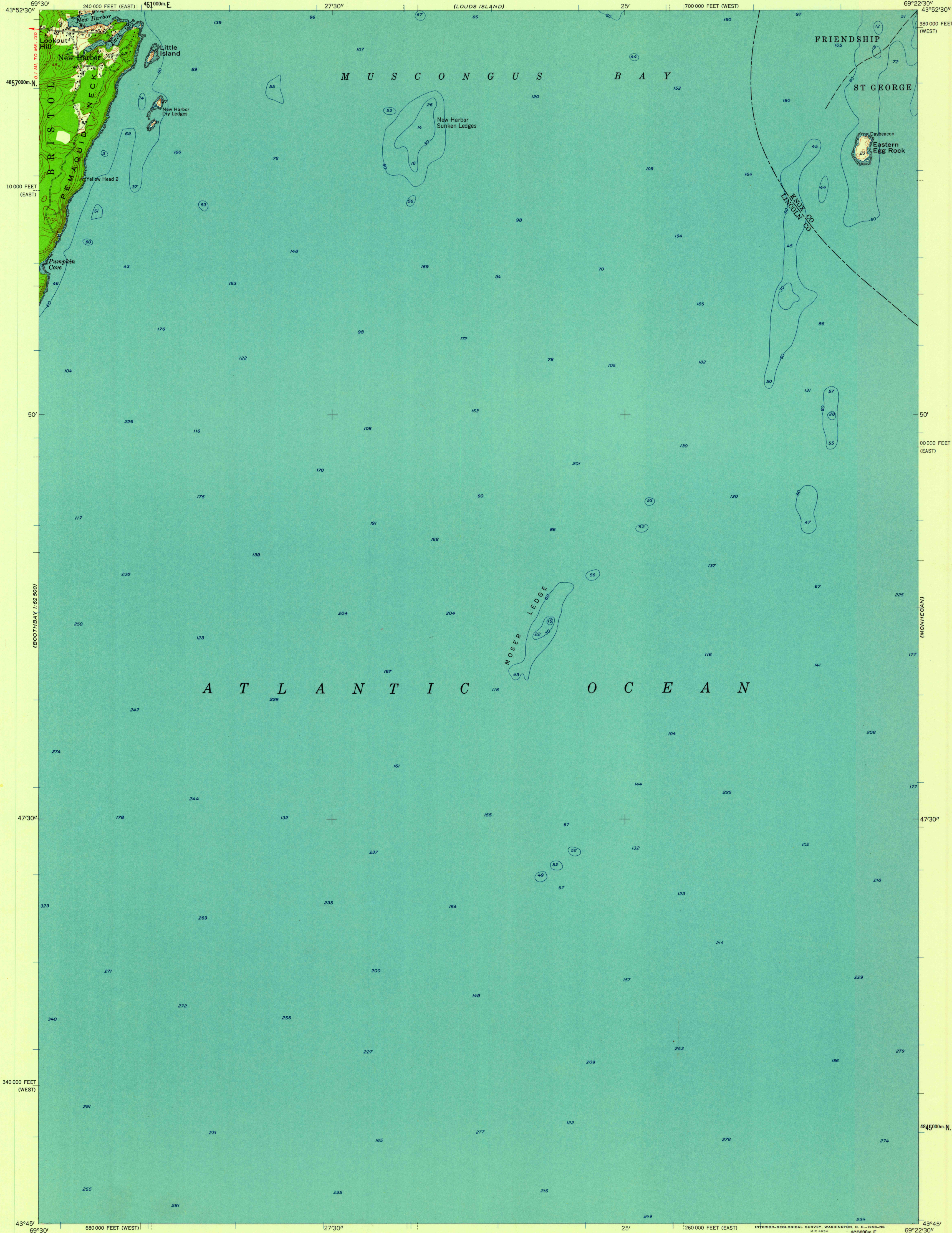

SW 1/4 MONHEGAN 15' QUADRANGLE

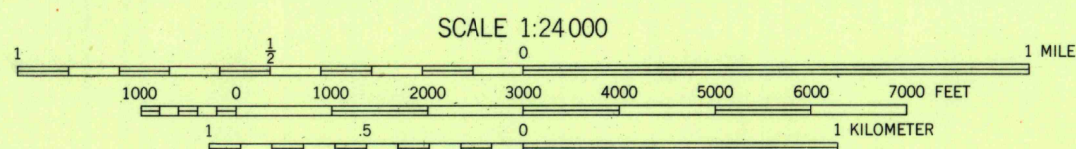
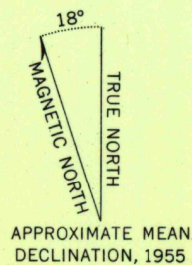
