

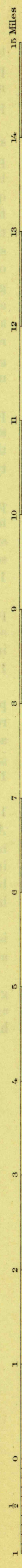

CASTINE QUADRANGLE

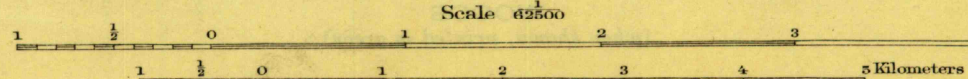
