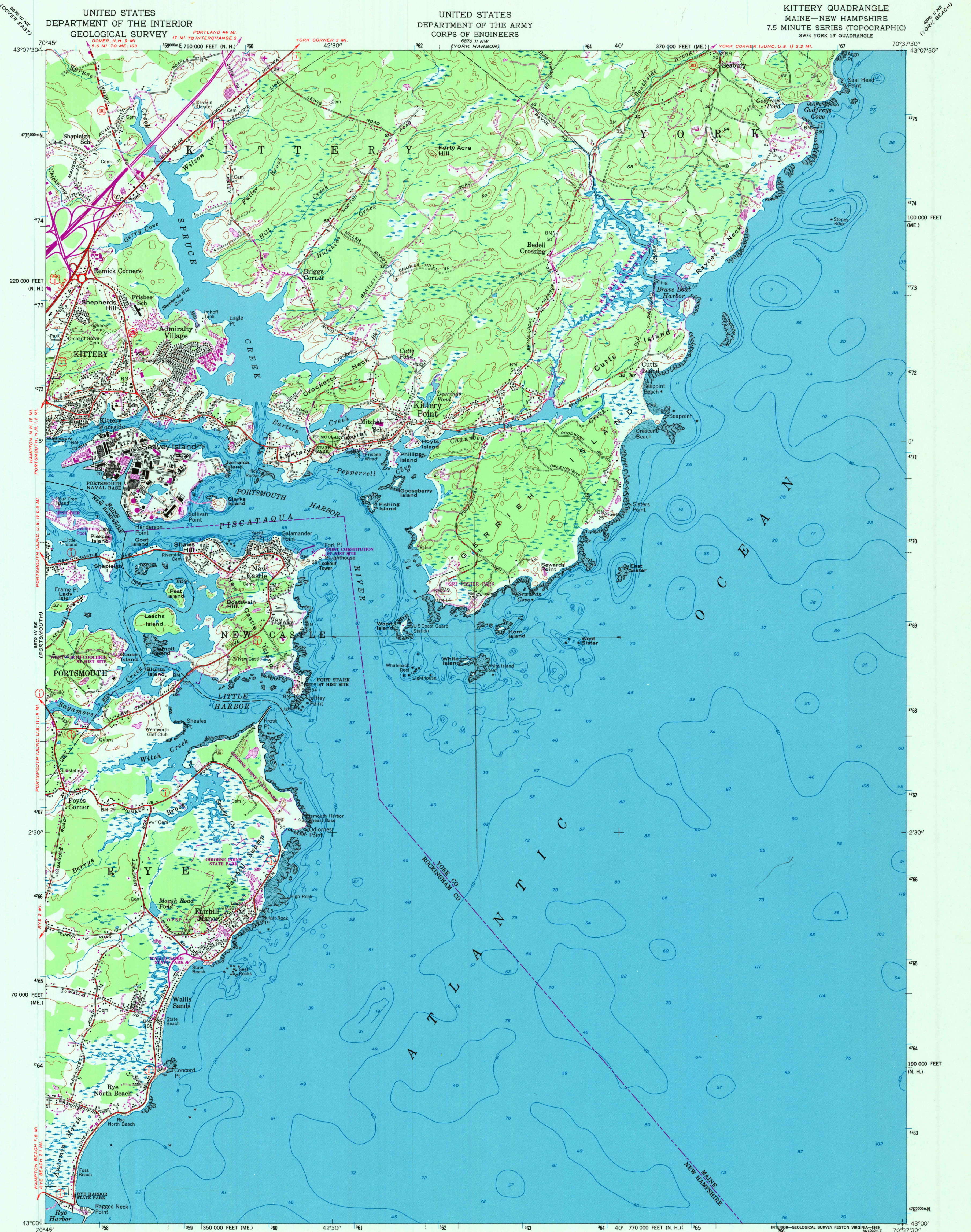

SW/4 YORK 15' QUADRANGLE



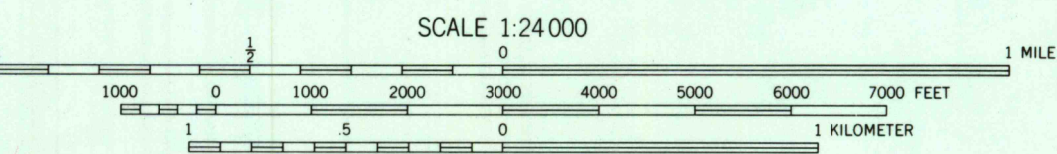
