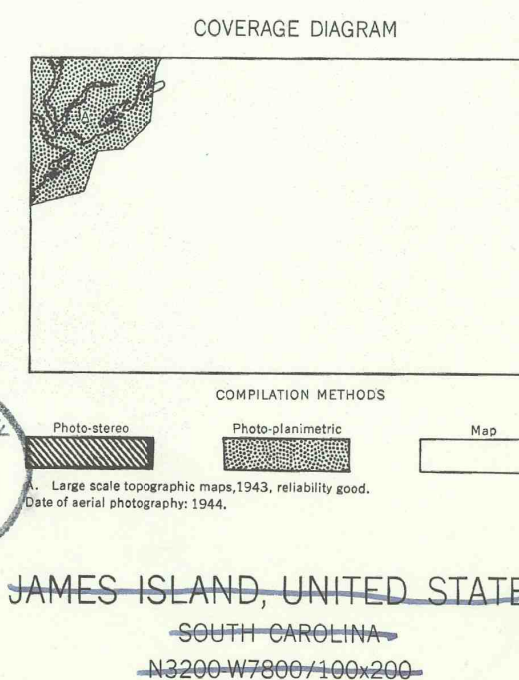
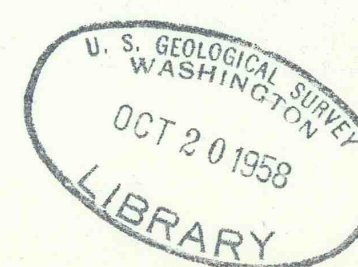
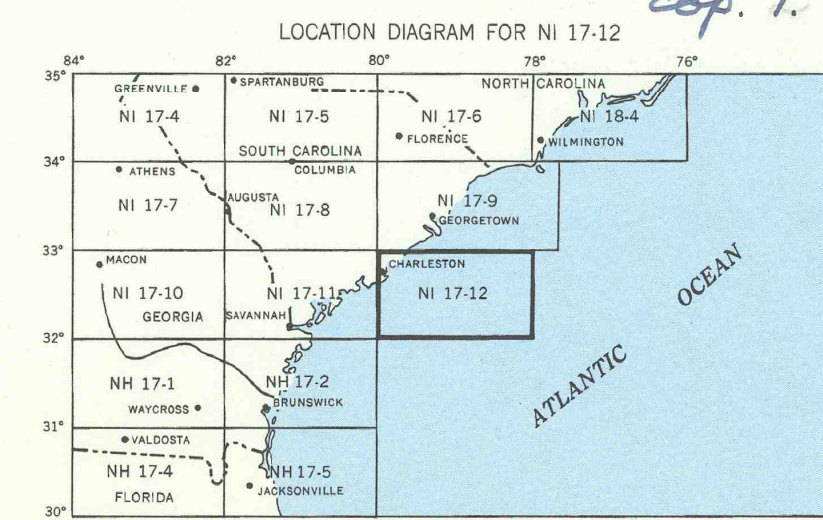
INDEX TO BOUNDARIES
