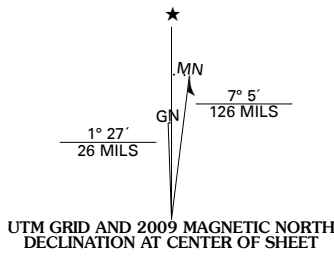


NICKEL MINE SPRING QUADRANGLE

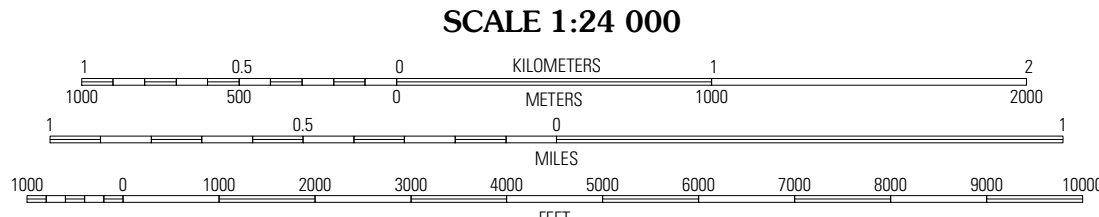

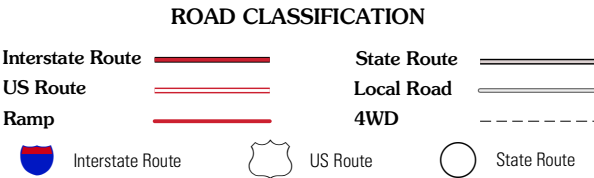
