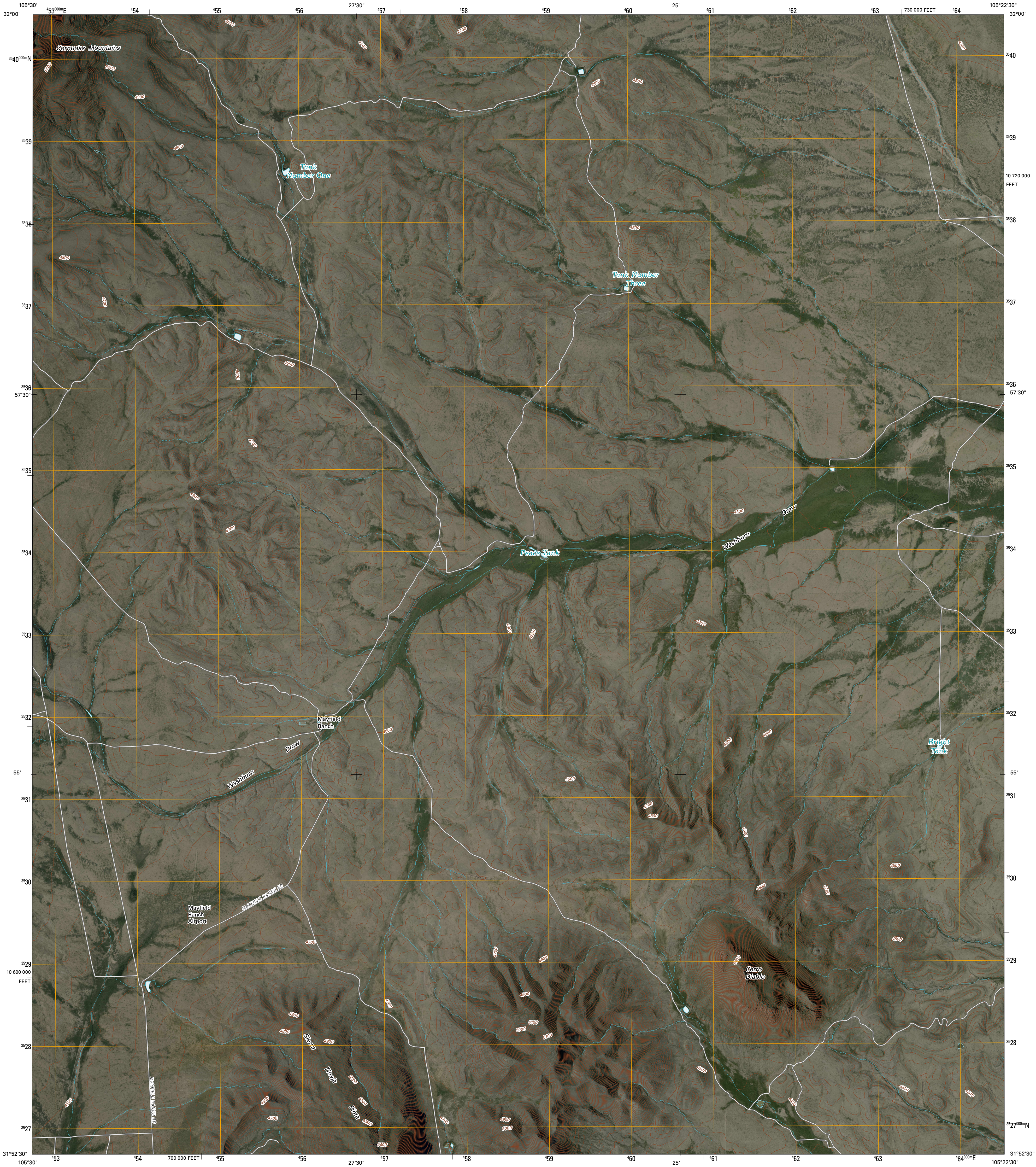

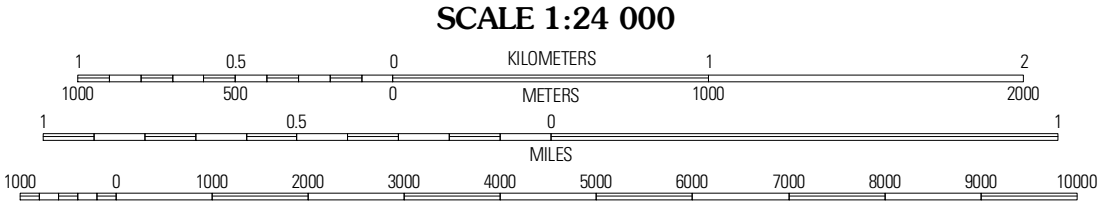
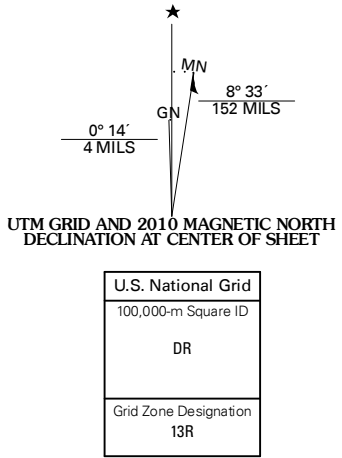


CERRO DIABLO QUADRANGLE

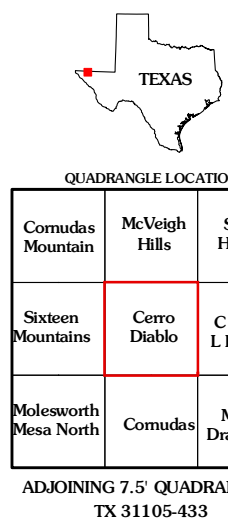

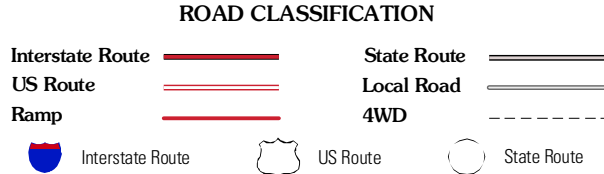
