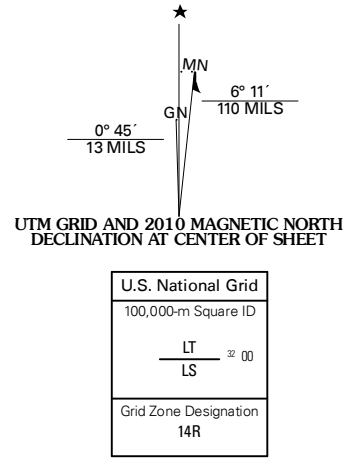


QUEMADO EAST QUADRANGLE

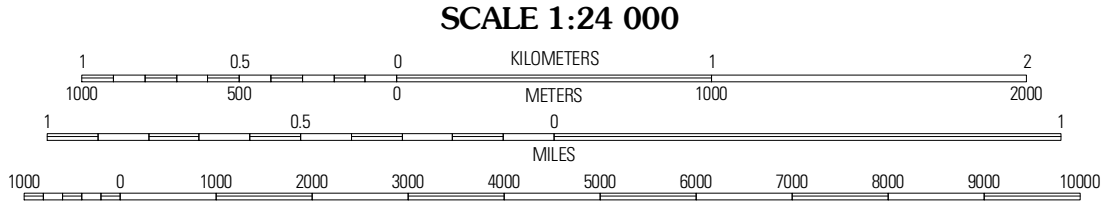

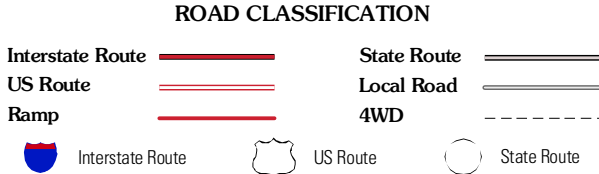
