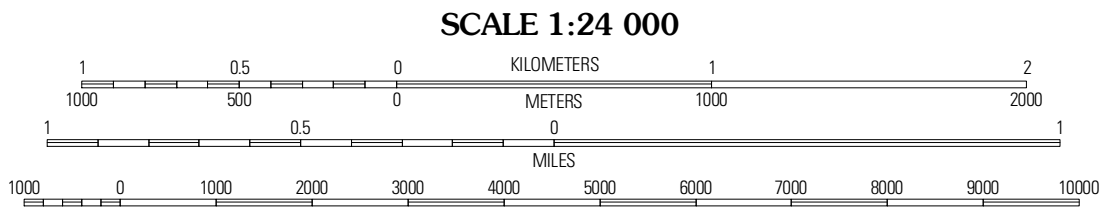
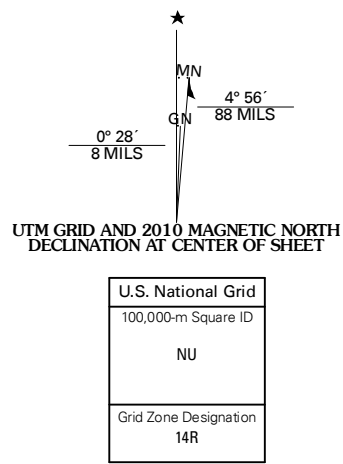


DRIPPING SPRINGS QUADRANGLE
