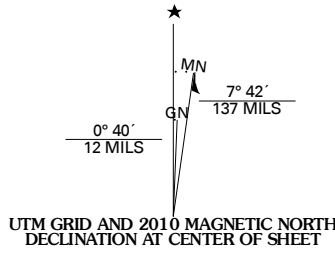


MAJOR PEAK QUADRANGLE

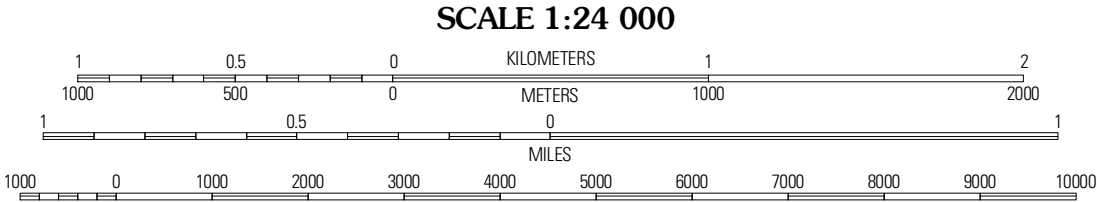

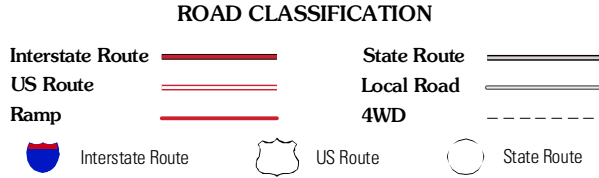
