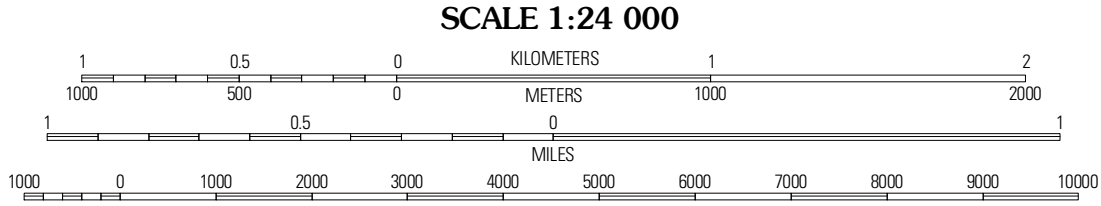
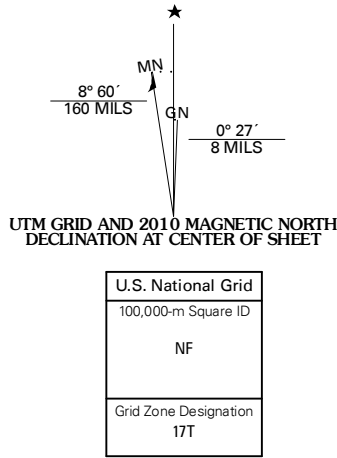

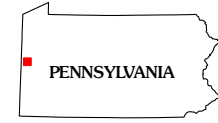

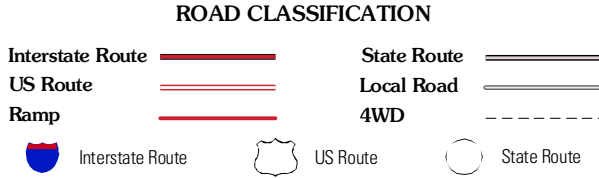


CONTOUR INTERVAL 40 FEET
