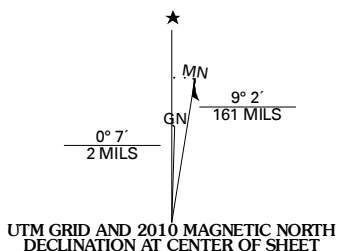


BRACEWELL QUADRANGLE

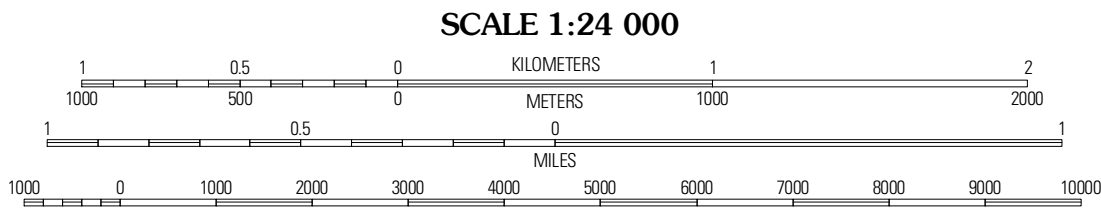

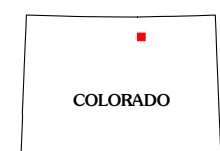

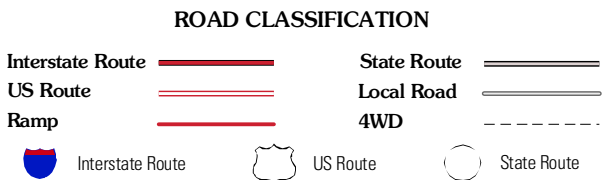
