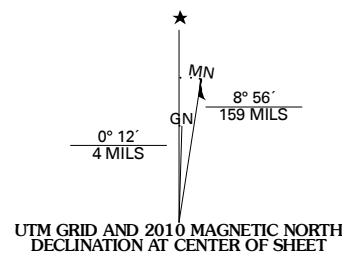


MILE HIGH LAKES QUADRANGLE

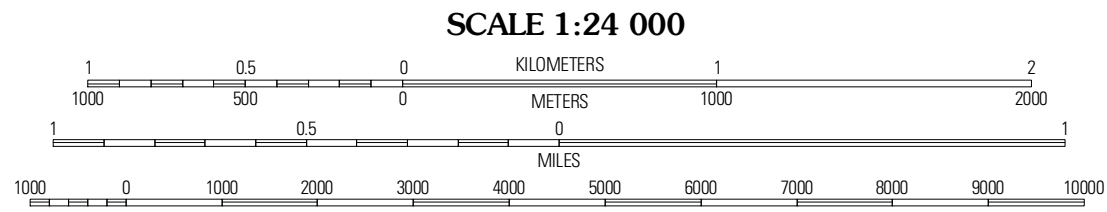

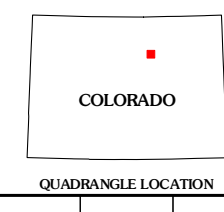

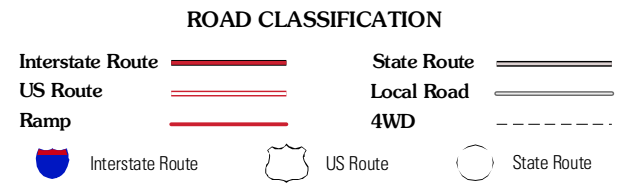
