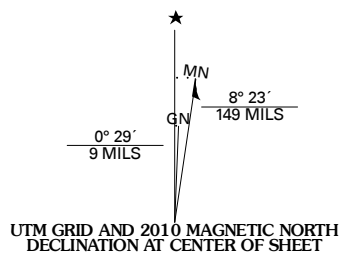


PINE BUTTES QUADRANGLE

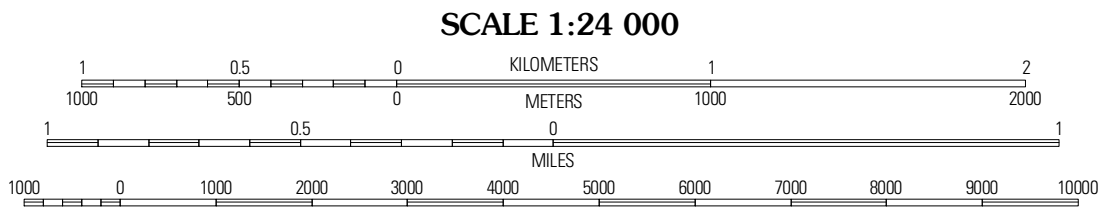

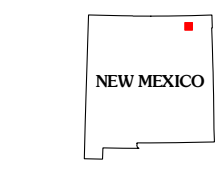
