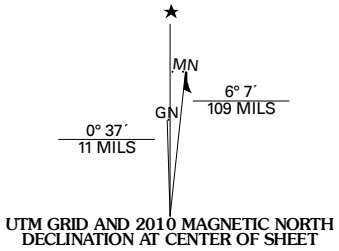

7.5-MINUTE SERIES

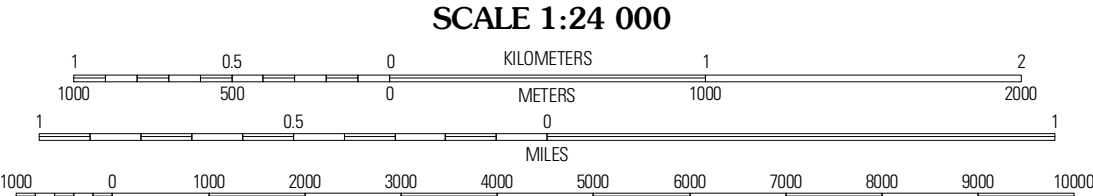

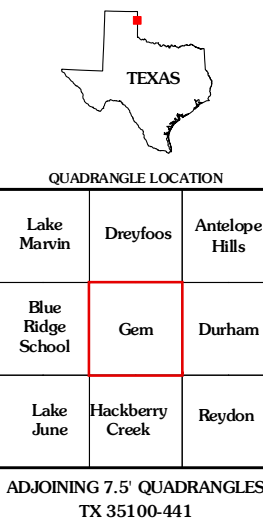
