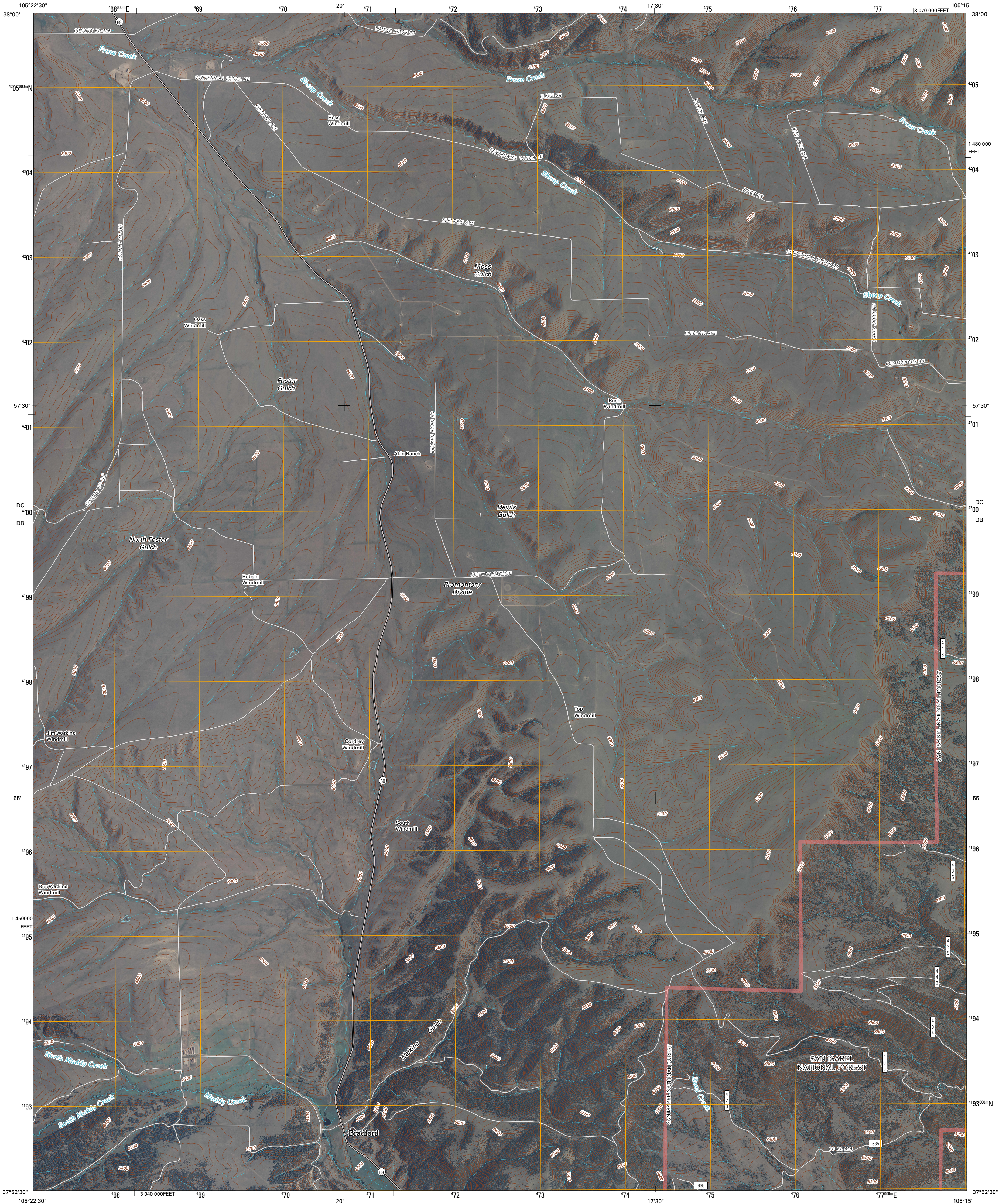

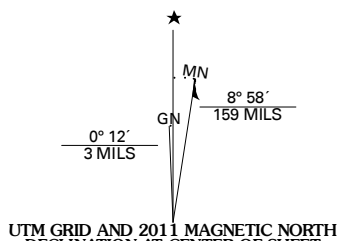


DEVILS GULCH QUADRANGLE

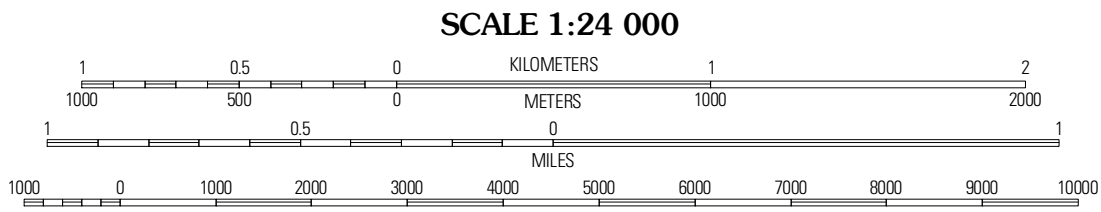
