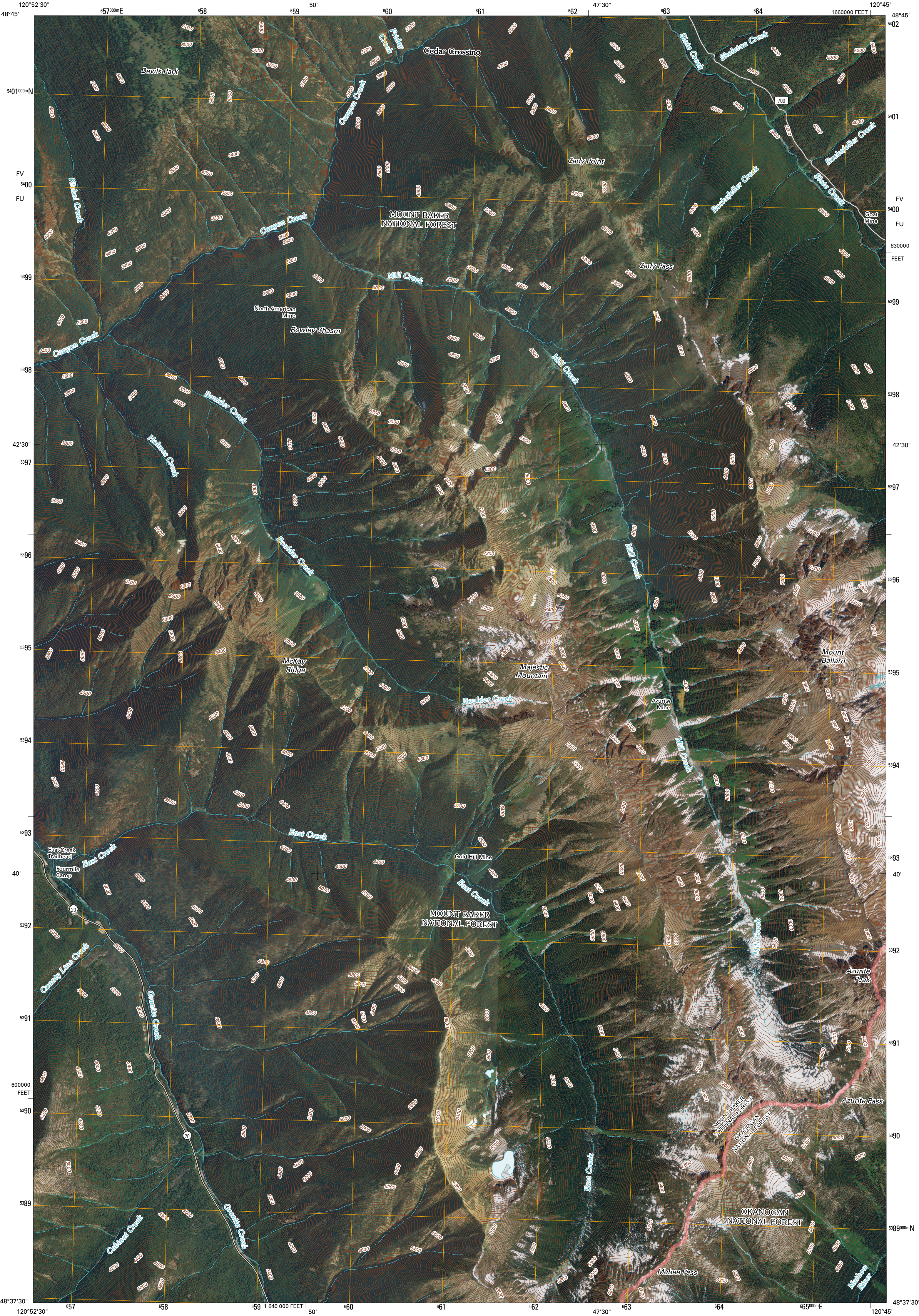

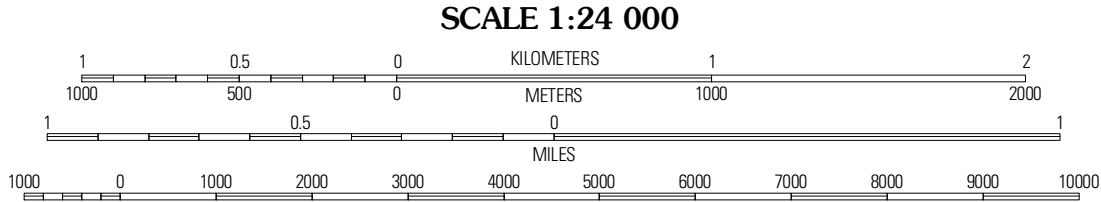
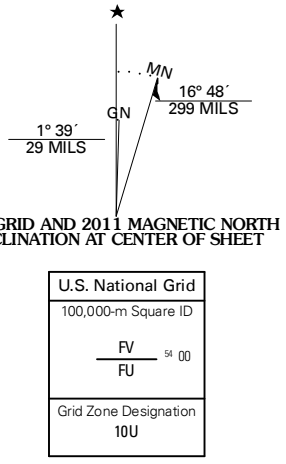


AZURITE PEAK QUADRANGLE
